Not Strong Enough

Feeling utterly alone, she desperately needed someone to talk to about her situation. So Gracie called the number she saw in an online ad for Pregnancy Decision Line (PDL). The pregnancy decision coach listened as Gracie shared her story. And then Gracie asked, "How can I be expected to kill my own child?"

But what scared Gracie the most was that she found herself contemplating the unthinkable.

Though she preferred adoption, she confessed that she lacked the courage to ignore her boyfriend's demands.

She was seriously considering aborting her baby.



A Father's Support



Joylene hadn't taken a pregnancy test, but after missing her period, she discussed options with her long-time boyfriend who told her he "would be supportive of any decision she made." She then called our Pregnancy Decision Line (PDL) for information about abortion, wanting to make an informed decision.

As the PDL coach and Joylene talked, the PDL coach encouraged Joylene to consider the support she had around her. The expectant mother explained that she and her boyfriend planned to get married.

Joylene's situation highlights two truths: fathers matter and marriage matters.

Unfortunately, Joylene's boyfriend's response reflects a culture that demands fathers remain silent. But his quiet support and desire to marry her gave Joylene strength to explore all of her options.

A recent study by Lifeway Research found that 4 in 10 women who have had an abortion say the father of the baby was most influential factor in their decision.

This means fathers are the primary influencer in 400,000 of the 1 million abortions that occur each year!

Part 1 of a 4-Part Series on Being Pro Abundant Life

As you may know, I served for 11 years as president of the National Fatherhood Initiative. During that time, countless people asked me, in one form or another, what it means to be a good dad. Over time, I realized that three words that truly capture the heart of what fatherhood is all about: involved, responsible, and committed.

You see, in God's design, men are called to be the providers, protectors, and priests for their families. That high calling to fathers is the reason they can make such an enormous difference in the lives of their children, for good or for ill.

A study conducted by Lifeway Research found that pregnant mothers consider the father of the baby to be the most influential factor, by far, in her decision to abort or not.

We also know from decades of social science research that children with involved fathers in their lives are significantly less likely to live in poverty, be abused or neglected, use drugs, become incarcerated, drop out of school, become pregnant as teens, and suffer from childhood obesity than children in father-absent homes.

When a couple is making a pregnancy decision and after a child is born (indeed, for the child's whole life), it's clear that fathers play a critical role. Therefore, we are called to help fulfill the "fatherhood promise" God makes to precious lives in the womb and to honor God's call to fathers to be involved, responsible, and committed.

This sets us apart as not just pro-life people, but PRO ABUNDANT LIFE people. That is why we take the following pledge:

As pro abundant life people, we will celebrate and encourage father involvement during pregnancy decisions and throughout the lives of the children who need them.
