Watchman Nee was a Chinese Christian who was imprisoned for his faith from 1952 until his death in 1972. He wrote the book *Sit, Walk, Stand*, a study of Ephesians, while imprisoned in the 1950s.

I recently studied a devotional based on it, and I was reminded of our work to protect unborn children and help them have abundant lives in Christ.

I thought especially about the men and women working in Care Net's 1,160 pregnancy centers who bravely fight for life despite being often misunderstood and actively hindered.

These faithful workers are certain of their place in Christ. They **sit** with Him at the Father's throne (Ephesians 2:6), peaceful, knowing God is with them always as they serve Him. They are strengthened to operate in a culture that devalues unborn lives and disguises abortion as a harmless "choice".
