- Initiate, analyze, monitor, evaluate, and alter strategic advancement plans.
- Articulate to donors and foundations in writing, phone calls, and in personal meetings Care Net's vision, mission, value proposition, case for support, and strategic initiatives.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Between one and three years of direct solicitation (fundraising) experience or related experience, e.g. business development, sales, etc.
- Is a committed Christian, with a strong commitment and dedication to evangelism, the pro-life position, and the sanctity of the family
- Demonstrated ability to grow a portfolio or segment of donors or clients by building and maintaining long-term relationships with individuals and organizations being solicited
