Please be advised that the holder of this letter is an employee of LONG Building Technologies (LONG) and is authorized to perform work and provide equipment in areas restricted by shelter-in-place mandates in accordance with the Department of Homeland Security, Cyber Security (CISA) measures on essential business and services.
