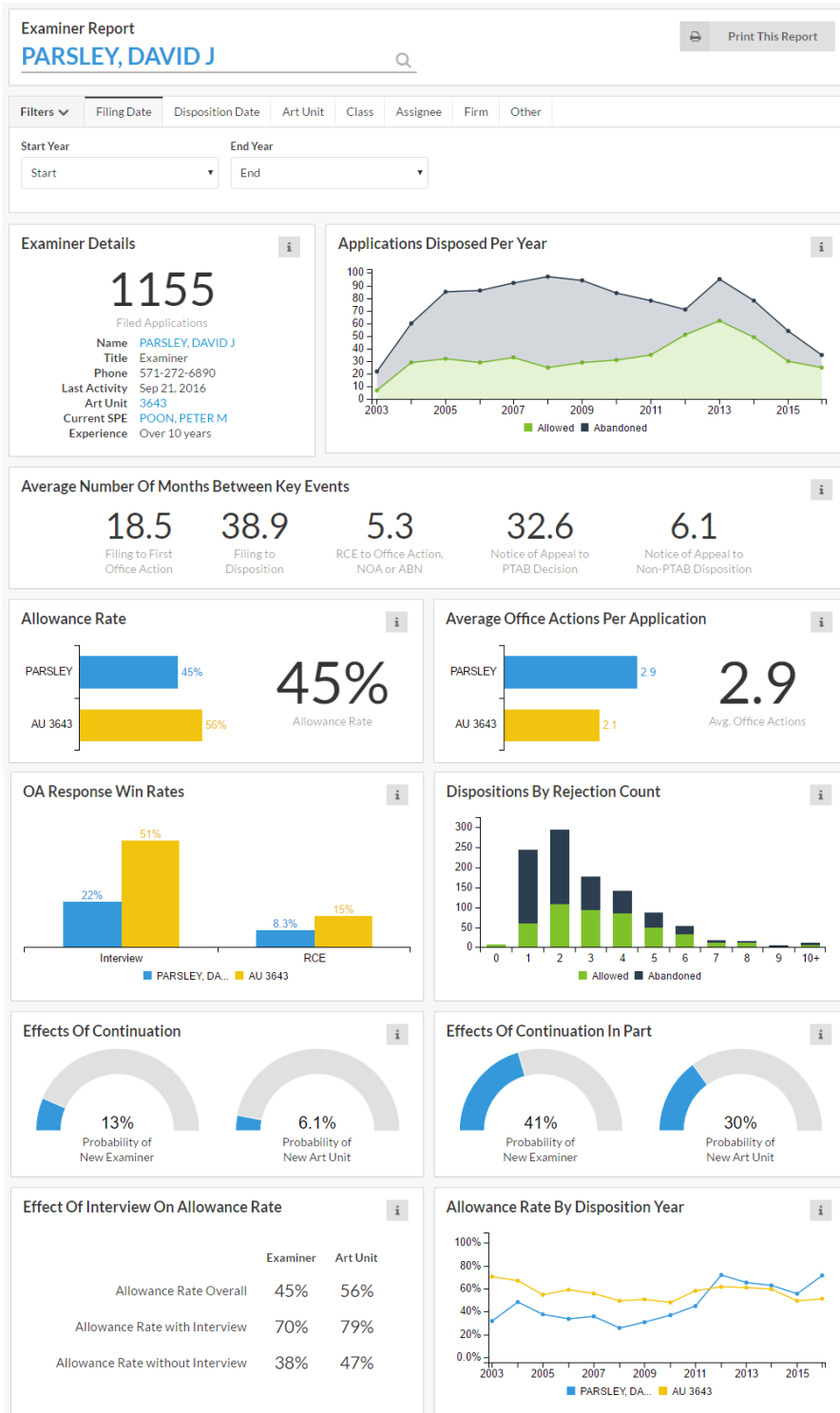

# EXAMINER

## THE BASICS

An Examiner Report is an interactive tool that helps attorneys and agents predict the future. It provides actionable insights that help practitioners impress clients, partners, and (of course) patent examiners. Moreover, the information is tailorable to your needs. Every Examiner Report includes filtering options that let you narrow results by application type, art unit, and time.



## FILTERS & OVERVIEW

All Examiner Reports let you filter by filing date, disposition date, art unit, class, assignee, firm, and more. Below the filters, you'll find preliminary examiner details and a graphical breakdown of disposed applications over time. You can also view by filing date by clicking the "i" icon.

## EXAMINER TIMINGS

We also include average timings between key events. In this example, you can expect to wait about 18.5 months for your first office action and about 38.9 months for final disposition.

## ALLOWANCE RATE & OFFICE ACTIONS

Every Examiner Report provides the allowance rate of the examiner as compared to their art unit. Comparative office action averages are also provided.

## OFFICE ACTION WIN RATES & DISPOSITION AFTER REJECTION

In addition to the averages discussed above, each Examiner Report includes win/loss rates for RCEs, appeals, and examiner interviews. This information helps users justify strategies, maximize profits, and budget predictably. The graph on the right shows disposition results after a given number of rejections.

## CONTINUATIONS & CIPs

Ever wonder if you can get out of a particular art unit or avoid a particular examiner? This section shows your chances of doing just that after filing a continuation or CIP.

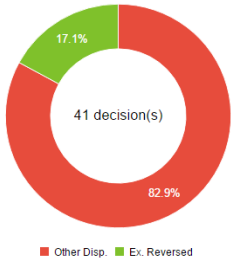
## ALLOWANCE RATE OVER TIME & CLAIMS CHANGES

Examiner Reports make it easy to see how an examiner's allowance rate has changed over time. You can also see how many claims and words are gained/lost on average.



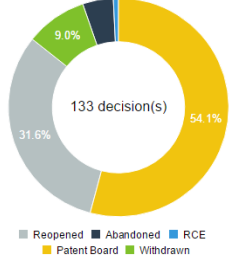

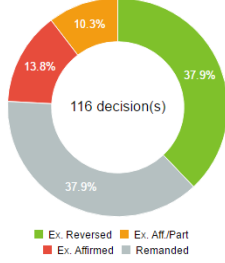

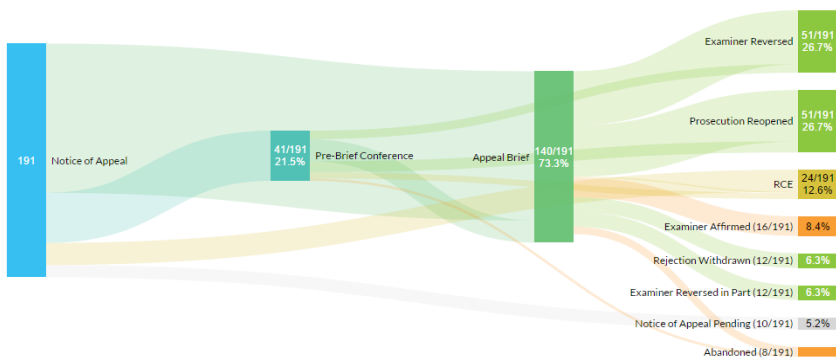


### APPEAL OUTCOMES BY STAGE

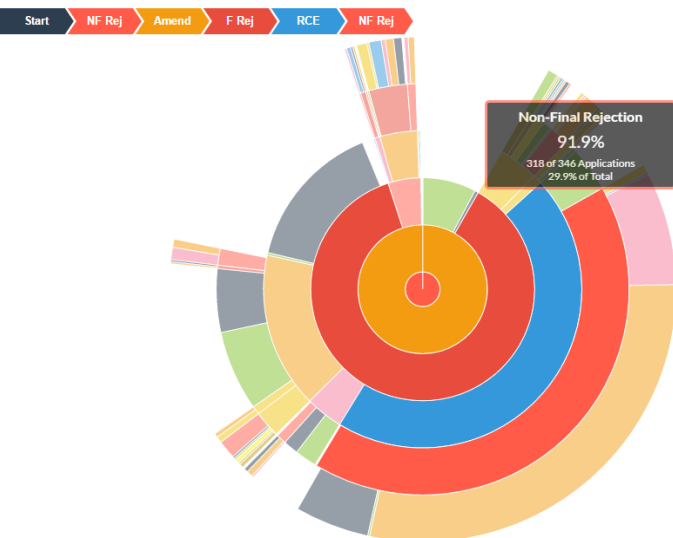

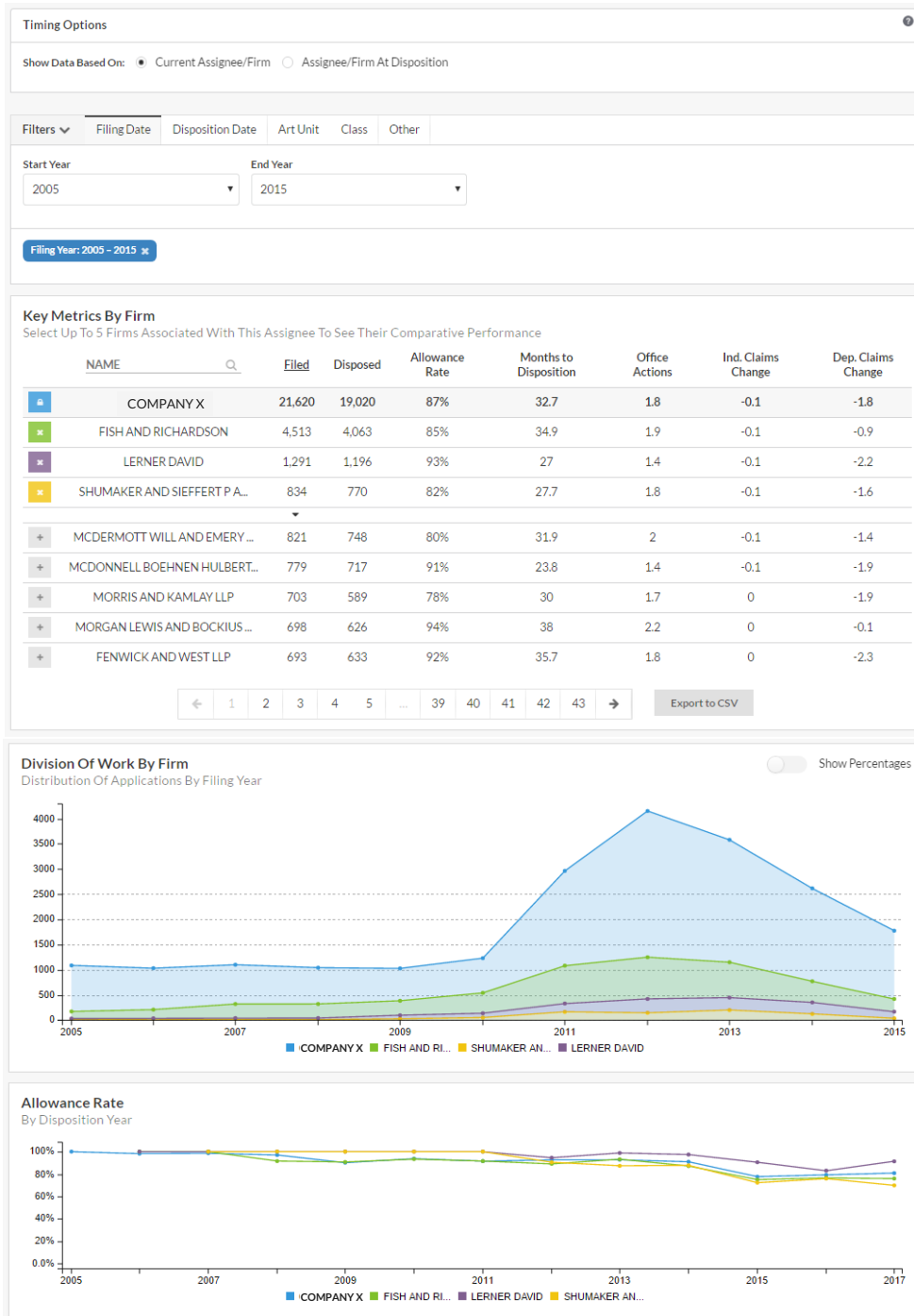

### TIMING OPTIONS & FILTERS

Tailor Juristat Business Intelligence to show exactly what you need. Begin by selecting your preferred timing: *Current Assignee/Firm* or *Assignee/Firm At Disposition*. You can also filter by filing date, disposition date, art unit, class, and more.

### KEY METRICS

See where your organization stands on allowance rate, average number of office actions, time to disposition, and claim changes. You can add or remove entities using the "+" boxes on the left. These selections are reflected throughout the report.

When viewing a company report, this chart shows the share of work for the firms selected above. When viewing a firm report, this section displays the selected assignees. Hover over the graph for a more granular view.

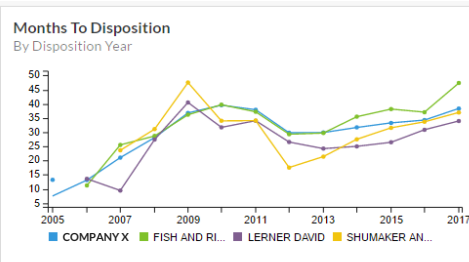
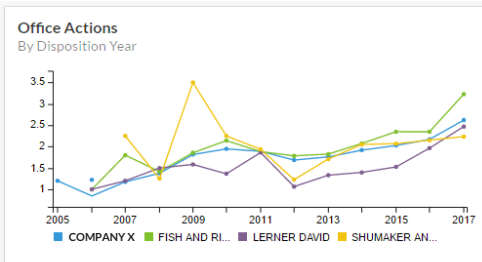
### ALLOWANCE RATE OVER TIME

This section displays an entity's allowance rate over time. On a firm report, this will include any assignees selected in the *Key Metrics* table. On a company report, this will include the selected firms.



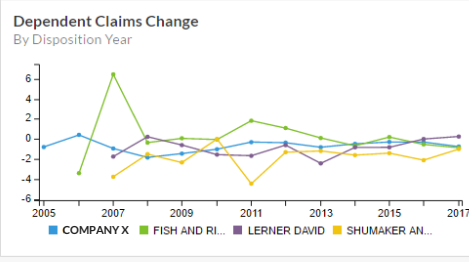
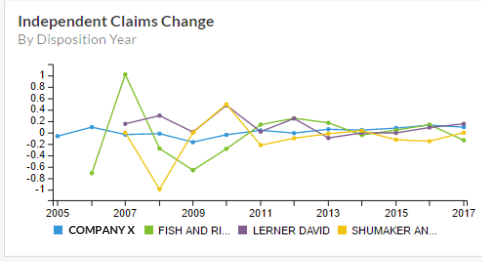

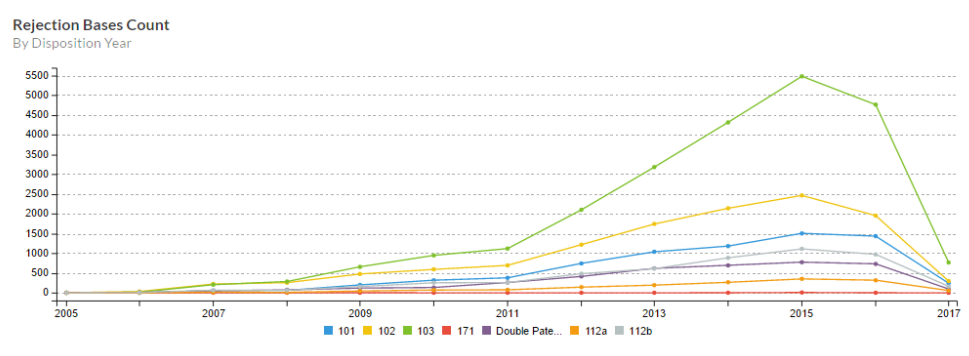
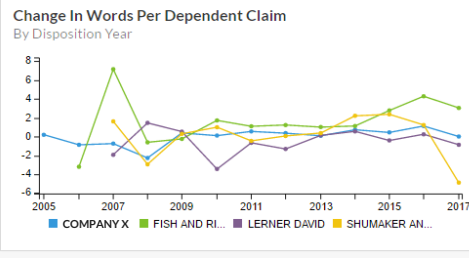
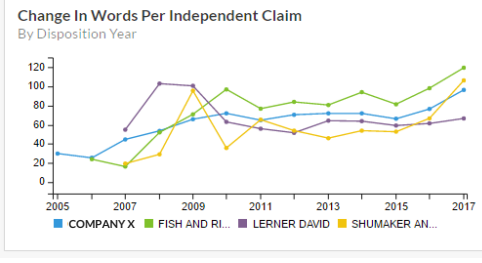
## OFFICE ACTIONS & TIMINGS

These graphs display average office action win rates and time to disposition over time. This makes it easy to spot a positive or negative trend.



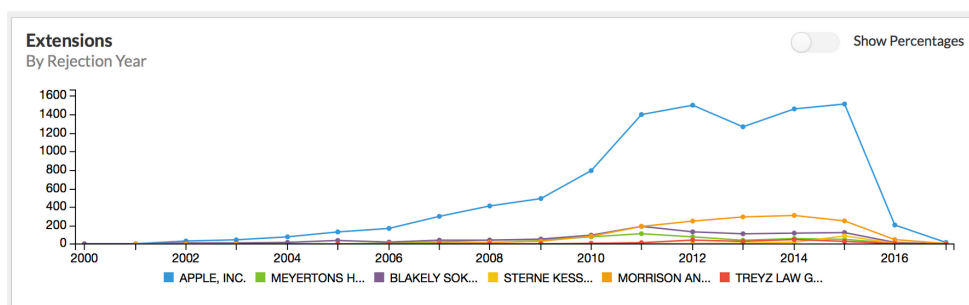
## CLAIM & WORD CHANGES

# DRAFTING

## THE BASICS

Juristat Drafting predicts your application's classification and identifies the specific claim language that is influencing its prediction. The best way to beat a harsh classification is to avoid one altogether. Using this groundbreaking tool, you can do just that.

The Claims Editor interface includes a text area for claim language, a USPC classification selector with up/down arrows, and a Keywords list with a search box and suggestions.

## SUMMARY

Juristat Drafting is easy to use. Simply paste your claim language and hit *Classify*. In a matter of seconds, you'll see the tool's predicted classification. Results under 5% are not shown.

## SYNONYM SUGGESTIONS

Choose the desired classification by selecting the appropriate *up* arrow. Indicate the classification you wish to avoid with a *down* arrow. Thereafter, simply choose a keyword on the right to see the tool's recommended synonyms. Within minutes, you can decrease your chances of landing in an unfavorable class by double digits.

## DETAILED CLASSIFICATION RESULTS

Dive deeper using Juristat Drafting's Classification Results table. Here, you can toggle between Art Unit, Tech Center, USPC, or CPC. In addition to the probabilities of each classification, the table includes average allowance rate and average number of office actions. You can even see the likelihood of receiving an *Alice* rejection. These results update each time you hit *Classify*.
