Join our community of artists and makers and spend your summer building a portfolio of new and exciting artwork! The goal of the Pre-College Summer Studio Art Intensive program is to coach students through creating conceptually sophisticated artwork. As you learn to work with new materials and deepen your understanding of familiar mediums, you will make connections to bigger ideas.

During the course of the program, you will participate in foundations classes that will blur the lines between disciplines. Taught by a team of skilled artists and educators, these classes will include instruction in technical skills such as drawing, painting, sculpture, and digital media.

- Work one-on-one with a faculty or art student mentor to develop your portfolio
- Expand your art practice with the introduction of new materials and ideas
- Refine your approach to making art and create in your own studio space
- Learn and grow through group critiques led by instructors and visiting artists
- Explore our fine arts Fenway campus, while living on the Tufts' Medford campus
- Take advantage of visits to local museums, such as the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston
