

Our History

Westminster Village is a community of Presbyterian Senior Living. In 1972 PSL purchased the Central Park Nursing Home in Allentown, renaming it Lehigh Manor. In 1983, the Board changed the name to Westminster Village Health Center and the entire complex to Westminster Village at Allentown.



Presbyterian Senior Living was founded in 1927 as a not-for-profit organization providing housing and health care to older adults. Since its beginning in 1927, caring for nine elderly ladies in a farm house in Newville, Pennsylvania, it has grown to providing care for hundreds of residents in 30 different locations throughout the mid-Atlantic region. It is governed by a volunteer Board of Trustees. PSL, located in Dillsburg, PA, has spent more than 88 years building communities that make residents feel at home. One of the hallmarks of this organization is that throughout its history not a single resident has ever been asked to leave its facilities due to their inability to pay for their cost of care through no fault of their own. Last year, Presbyterian Senior Living provided \$29.8 million in benevolent support to residents; over \$4.8 million was provided at Westminster Village at Allentown.

Westminster Village Fact Sheet

- Westminster Village is a Continuing Care Retirement Community, or CCRC, in the city of Allentown.
- Westminster Village (WVA) offers three levels of care and services – skilled nursing, short-term rehab, memory support, personal care and independent living apartments.
- Every day brings something new and exciting for the residents to enjoy. All residents are urged to engage in the nationally acclaimed Masterpiece Living, which offers the opportunity, for residents in all three levels of care, to get involved, spiritually, intellectually, artistically and physically.
- WVA has a strong reputation for high-quality services and is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF), an independent, not-for-profit accrediting body widely regarded as the “seal of excellence” in CCRC’s.
- Services are delivered by registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and certified nurse aides. The facility employs 230 men and women.
- There is an active volunteer program, deploying 75 volunteers who assist staff to enhance care to residents.
- Today, the complexion of WVA continues to change and grow with an active auxiliary that meets monthly to support the needs of WVA.
- WVA accepts Medicare, Medicaid and Veteran’s Benefits.
- WVA has been designated as a preferred provider by St. Luke’s University Health Network. The network includes multiple locations with a hospital as close as two miles away.

The Financial Equation

Presbyterian Senior Living (PSL) has committed \$873,000 from capital to the project, bringing the total cost of the project to \$1,123,000. The renovations are underway and are anticipated to be complete on the second and third floors by the end of the current calendar year. Renovations on the first floor will proceed as funds are received from this campaign.

Campaign Goals

Renewed surroundings for residents most in need of care.

- We seek to raise \$250,000 for the renovation of 57 health center rooms at Westminster Village in Allentown.
- Renovations will include new flooring, updated bathrooms, wall coverings and window treatments.
- All three floors of the health care center have identical floor plans and contain a separate, updated dining room.
- The health center rooms are also occupied by short and long term rehabilitation residents and care is provided for up to 23 residents in need of memory support on the first floor.
