How to Stay Safe Online:

1. Install anti-virus protection software on your computer.
2. Check to make sure the website is legitimate.
3. Keep your passwords safe and secure.
4. Always use strong passwords and update them every 3 months.
5. Never open emails from senders you don't know.
6. Before initiating online transactions or filling out forms, read the website's privacy policy so you know exactly how your information will be used.
7. Never send personal information via email.
