

A Cat with the Balloons card by Olesya Kharkova



Materials used: Transparent Bubbly stamp set (30-012) by Penny Black, white cardstock, white card base, red alpha stickers, Peacock Feathers distress ink, Spun Sugar distress ink, diy cloud stencil, clear mirror sequins, Chameleon Color Tones Super Set; Warm Gray 7 (WG7), Warm Gray 3( WG3), Dusty Rose (PK3), Crimson Red (RD4), Red Coral (RD2), Chameleon Color Tones pencils: Soft White (1/01), Black (25/02), Plum (9/02), Strawberry(8/02).

Instructions:



1. Stamp the image onto a separate piece of white paper using Memento Tuxedo Black ink.

2. Color the image using Chameleon pens like regular alcohol markers. The first coat with the Warm Gray 3 (the bullet nib), then darken up one side with the Warm Gray 7 (the bullet nib).



3. Choose the Crimson red pen ( the bullet nib) to color the darkest areas, then fill all the rest with the Red Coral pen ( the bullet nib) leaving a small crescent shape uncolored for highlighting.

4. Darken up the shades on the balloons with the Plum pencil; fill all the rest with the Strawberry color. Don't forget to mark the reflection on the opposite side to the highlight. Soften a bit the highlight with the Strawberry pencil (very light pressure).

5. Sponge the cardbase with the Peacock Feathers and the Spun Sugar distress inks. Prepare some clouds borders using diy stencil ( or hand drawing) and scissors. The final step is to place the clouds on upper and bottom sides of the card using double-sided tape. Pop up the cat with some foam tape. Add the sentiment and sequins to finish the card.
