Inspiration: I like to have little bags with me just incase I buy something. I don't really care for the plastic bags that you get in stores. So I made a bag and why not make it pretty. I am a girly person so I was inspired by all things pretty.

Materials Used: Chameleon Pens: Summer Sun (YL2), Sky Blue (BL3), Spring Meadow (YG3), Bubble Gum (PK3), Nude (NU00), Grass Green (GR3), Green Apple (GR1), Dark Sage (GR2), Cornflower Blue (BL4), Baby Blue (BL2)Turquoise (BG3), Lagoon (BG1), Lavender (BV2), Dusty Rose (PK2), Peony Pink (PK4), Fuchsia (PK5), Purple Grape (PR4), Mauve (VO2), Cinnamon (BR3), Warm Sunset (YO3) and Taupe (BR1), Blumenthal Craft Photo Fabric, Muslin, Maya Road Ribbon and Sewing Machine.

Instructions:

1. Print any image on a sheet of Photo Fabric. Using a laser printer is suggested so the ink does not bleed with the alcohol pens.

2. Color the face using Nude (NU00) and Peony Pink (PK4). Infuse NU00 for 5 seconds while coloring each section of the face. Add a little PK4 on the lips, cheeks and nose infusing 5 seconds each time.

3. Color the remaining image using all the colors. Color direct, no need to infuse just make it bold and colorful.

4. Take your muslin, ribbon and fully colored image and prepare for sewing. The photo fabric does not have a sticky side so you have to sew it onto your project. I

used the ribbon to hid the edge. You can use straight pins to attach first that way you sew it on straight.

5. Cute a separate piece of muslin and ribbon and sew into a strip for the handle. Now you can piece it all together and create your bag.
