



Cool Christmas Penguins with Jessica Sanders

A Christmas card tutorial
featuring
Chameleon Pens



Gather your supplies.

- Chameleon Pens:
 - Crimson Red (RD4)
 - Tangerine (OR3)
 - Sky Blue (BL3)
 - Green Apple (GR1)
 - Grass Green (GR3)
 - Cool Gray (CG8)
 - Deep Black (BK4)
- Christmas Penguins clear stamp & cutting dies by Stampendous
- Momento Tuxedo Black stamp pad
- Cardstock: white, red, Stardust White (Astrobrights)

Get started.

- Stamp your penguins, hats, and sweaters
- Stamp and cut out your sentiment

Color.

Penguin – brush nib

- Fuse BK4 for 7 seconds, color the wings, beginning at the shoulder and working down.
 - Color the side of the penguin with BK4, fusing 3 seconds.
 - Color the top of the head, no need to fuse.
 - For the beak, color with OR3.
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- To add shadows, fuse CG8 for 10 seconds. Color the edge of the tummy on the left, and the area above the feet.
 - Add another shadow under the head on the right side, fusing CG8 for 7 seconds.



Color.



Hats & Sweaters – brush nib

- For the blue & green hat, use colors BL3, GR1, and GR3. To create a soft fluffy effect, color in a circular motion, leaving small areas of lighter tones. Color each section after fusing your color - 7 seconds for the large area, and 3 seconds for the two small sections.
- Color the blue sweater using the same technique, fusing BL3 for 10 seconds.
- Optional: For the red sweater, fuse RD4 for 7 seconds, and color using short downward strokes, and color hopping along the line of the stripe.

Diecut your penguins, hats, and sweaters.

Assemble your card.
