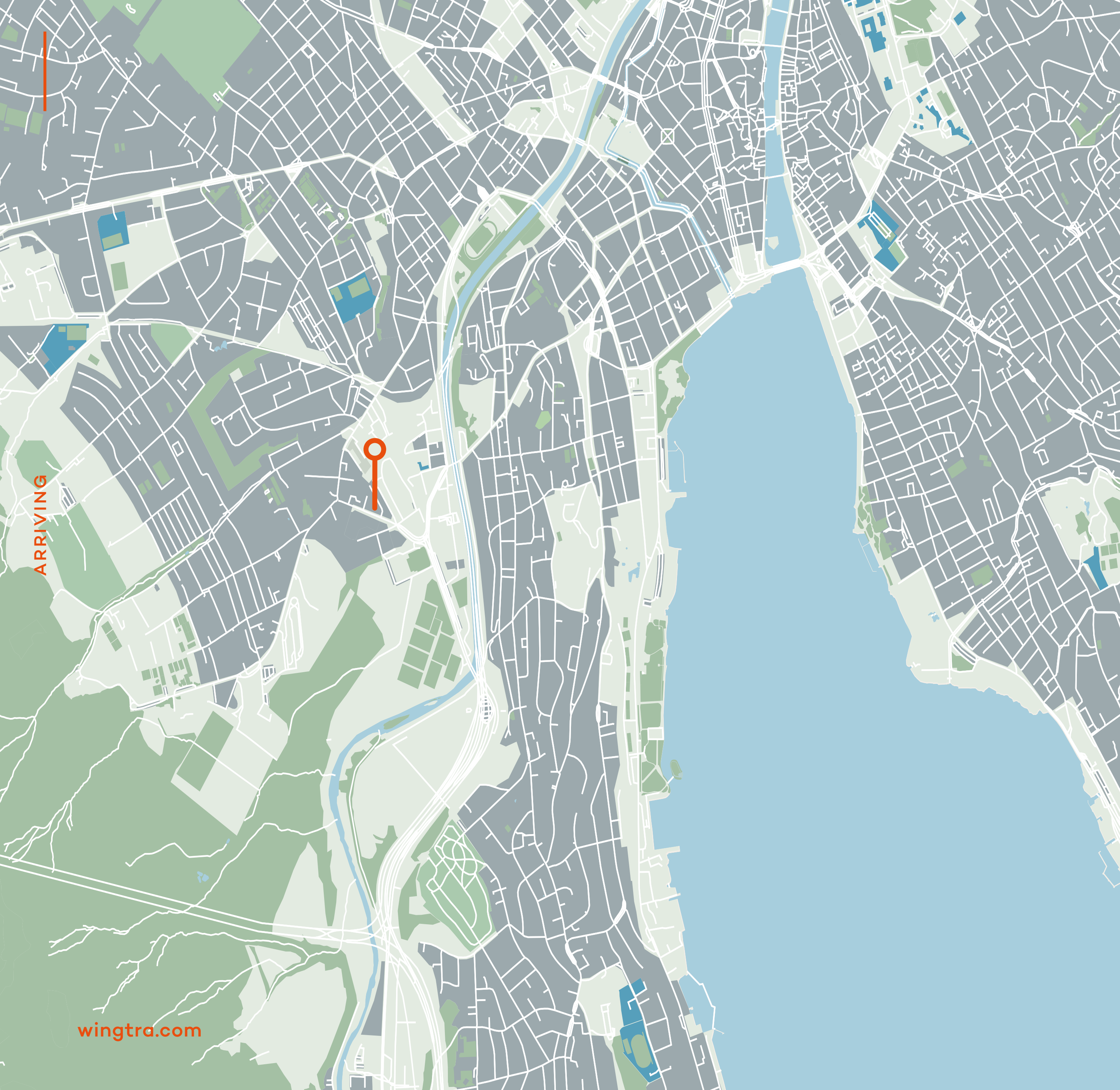

Arriving

Zurich Airport / By train

From Zurich Airport to Zurich Main Station (Zürich HB) it takes about 12 min by train. It's the fastest and cheapest way of getting there. As the Main Station is located very central, you may get anywhere in the city within minutes by bus, train or tram. For schedule please consult SBB homepage or their application (see below), where you can purchase your public transport tickets right away. Alternatively, get it at the SBB ticket counter or at the ticket machines one floor above the railways (Level Check-in 3, next to Starbucks). While Zurich Airport is the closest, Basel is also in reach, but it takes you 1 hour longer and the ticket will be 70CHF additional.





Wingtra Headquarter

Our Wingtra Headquarter (**Giesshübelstrasse 40, 8045 Zurich**) is located near the shopping center “Sihlcity”. At the Main Station take the tram 13 or 17 or train S4. They all go directly to the tram/train stop “Saalsporthalle” (it takes around 15 minutes). After arrival by tram turn right (direction of travel) - you can’t miss the exterior Wingtra sign.

By car

Arriving by car is easy, just as getting around within Zurich. Though you need to consider the huge traffic jams at peak hours on the one hand, and difficulties to find parking lots on the other hand. For short term visitors, the car park of **Brunaupark** just across the street from Wingtra Office is one option, **Sihlcity parking** another one. If staying more than one day,

Swiss Federal Railroad (SBB)

This is a useful public transportation application for Switzerland, where you can easily check the schedule and how to get to your anticipated location (within Europe). You can also get your tickets right there. Alternatively, there are [ZVV Apps](#) which serve the same function, but just for the canton of Zurich.



Uber

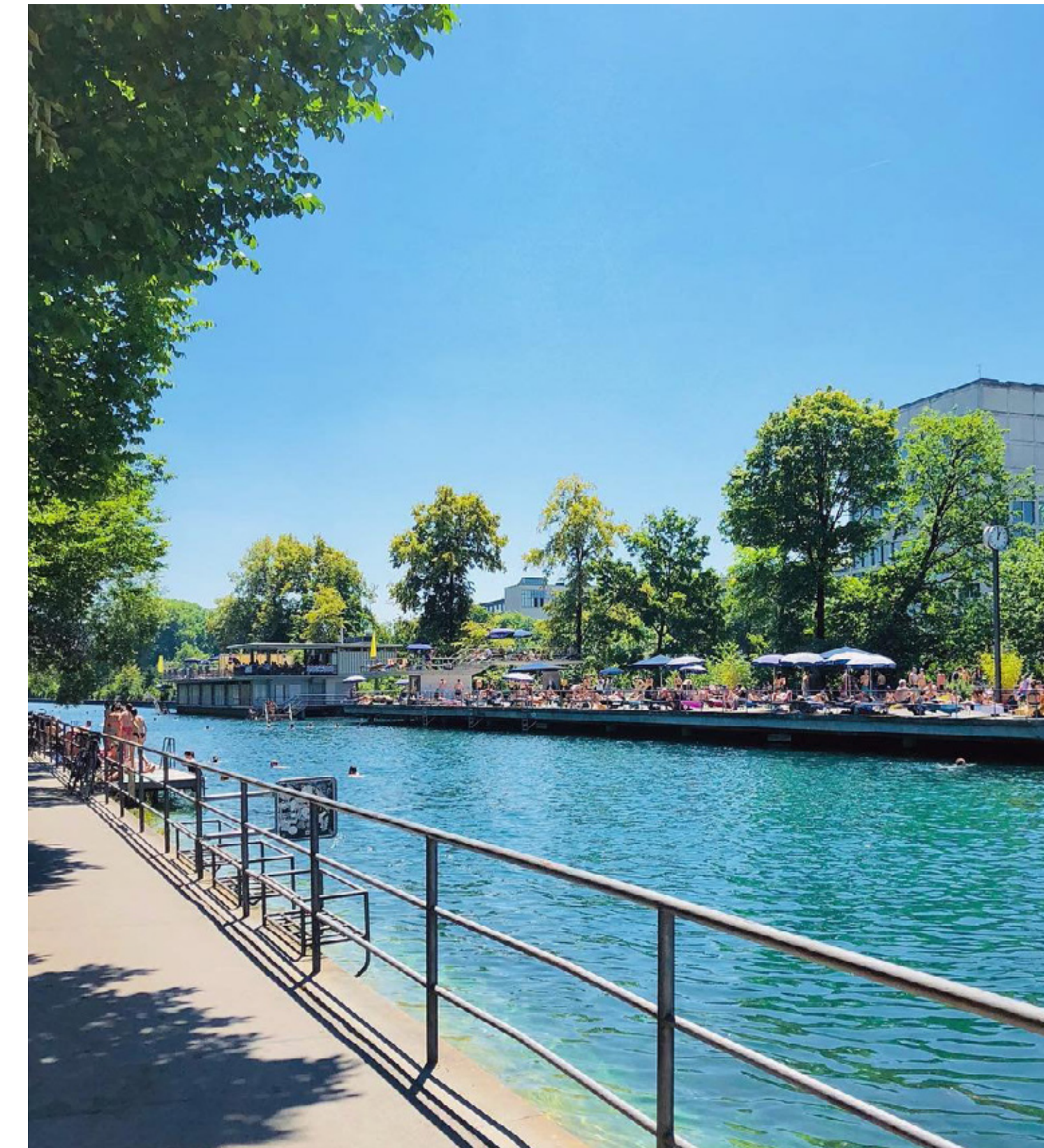
Uber is the recommended way of travelling if there is no public transport available. In Zurich we have plenty of Uber drivers, but in the countryside and in other cities it might get hard to find one. There you will have to catch a regular Taxi, which is around double the price of Uber.

If you don't use an Uber ask the taxi price beforehand as taxis in Switzerland are very costly. It's easiest to get around by train, bus and tram and you will only need taxis to get to the airport very early or to get home late ;)

Free Walking Tours

You could for example attend to one of the daily **Free Walking Tours** available in Zurich, which is a good way of getting to know more about the City. Otherwise walk up to Üetliberg, Zürberg (and Zurich Zoo) or Restaurant Waid. These are rather touristic activities, same as Bahnhofstrasse and Bellevue with its lake and city view. If you get the chance of a nice day, climb the Grossmünster observation deck (7 CHF), it's really worth it.



Good food

Traditional restaurants include **Zeughauskeller** and **Johanniter**. They are both a bit pricy, but that's hard to avoid in Switzerland. For a beer or Middle East food you can visit **Kleine Freiheit**, a café owned by Max and Elias.
