

## 30 Day Trial Guide

## Thank you for engaging in a trial with us! Please use this guide to help outline expectations during your trial.

- 1. You can choose to evaluate FlowWright by either choosing the 30 day downloadable trial edition (fully functioning) or by signing up for the 30 day online trial (most configuration and administrative functions will not be available in this version)
- 2. Follow the directions given in the automated email response. You shouldn't have any issues, but if you do then please send an email to <a href="mailto:support@flowwright.com">support@flowwright.com</a> or use our Google Forum to get questions answered.
- 3. Building around FlowWright is usually straightforward but remember that to accomplish your specific needs you will likely need to build out your user interfaces and reports to leverage the workflow, ESB, forms, and business intelligence capabilities of FlowWright.
- 4. There is excellent documentation available both within FlowWright itself and in the Developer Resources section of our website.
- 5. Many customers invest in on-site or remote (by web meeting) training or Proof-of-Concept services to accelerate development timeframes and decisions-making
- 6. At the end of 30 days, you can continue your evaluation by buying and annual subscription for a development license, which costs \$1,200 per year, and of course you can subscribe to licensing for a production server.
