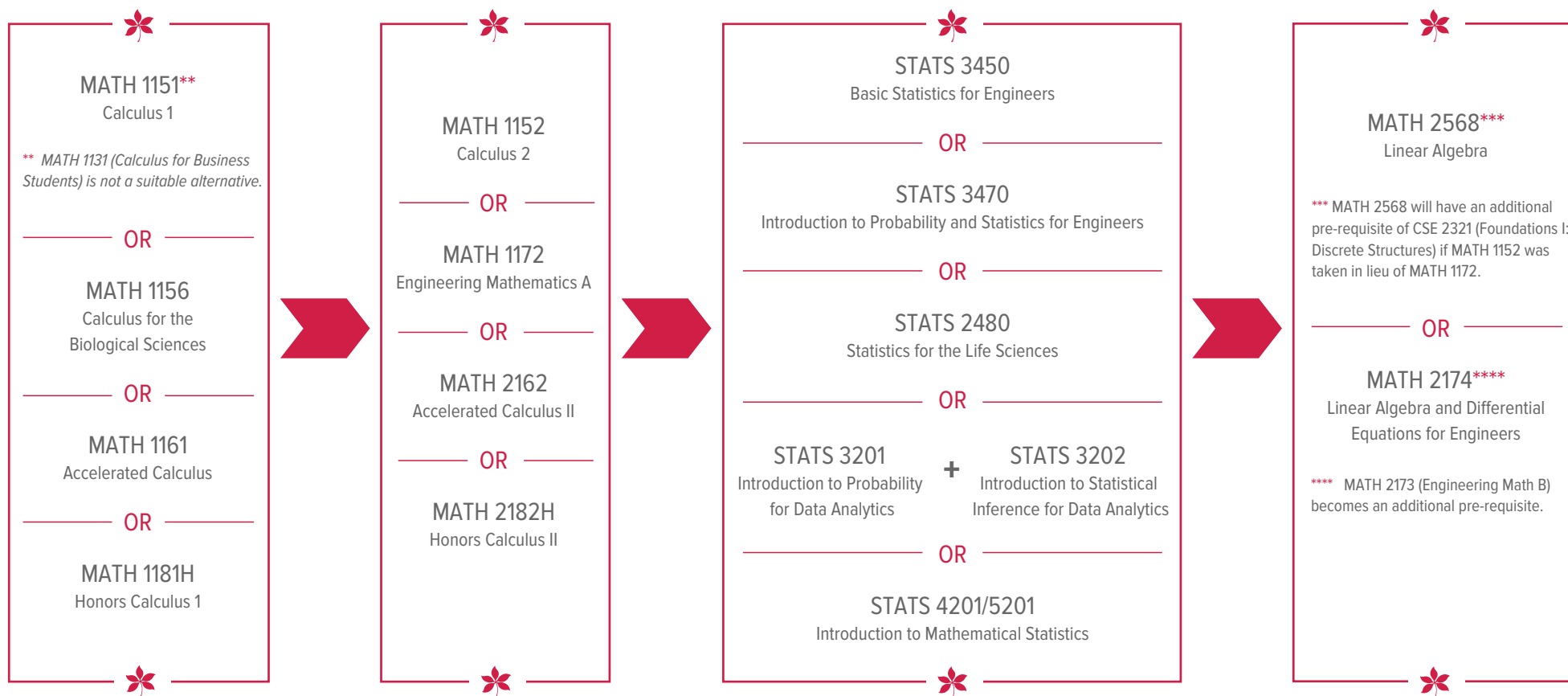


MBLE Quantitative Prep Roadmap for Undergrads

The following roadmap outlines the quantitative classes an undergraduate should take in order to be adequately prepared to apply to the MBLE program.* You should plan to earn at least a “B”. If the quantitative courses are completed with a “B” or higher and the applicant has a cumulative undergraduate GPA of a 3.5 or higher, the applicant may be eligible for The Graduate Admissions Test Exception (GATE) Program.

* It is also suitable to have tested out of the required courses.
