EVENT SUMMARY





EmTech Asia 2018: Where Technology, Business and Innovation Collide

The fifth edition of EmTech Asia, **co-organised by MIT Technology Review and Koelnmesse, and hosted by the Infocomm Media Development Authority** (**IMDA**) concluded on a high note after two days of stimulating and insightful discussions on the latest breakthroughs in science and technology.

Held from 30 to 31 January at the Marina Bay Sands Expo and Convention Centre, EmTech Asia was attended by over 700 like-minded individuals from 21 countries. This year's line-up of speakers included some of the brightest minds in the areas of artificial intelligence, quantum computing, robotics, automation, future cities, space and aerospace innovation, augmented and virtual reality, and precision medicine.

Bringing together an inspiring line up of 46 world leading scientists, entrepreneurs, investors and innovators, EmTech Asia featured speakers from Airbus, Google Deepmind, Hyperloop One, MIT, NVIDIA, Sony, SpaceX, among many. Highlights included Vivienne Ming's – one of Inc. Magazine's "Top 10 Women to Watch in Tech - inspiring presentation on the effect of systemic bias and advancements in AI on human capital and Shana Diez from SpaceX, who enthralled the audience with exclusive insights into SpaceX's reusable rocket technology and the company's plans to colonise Mars.

For the fifth year, EmTech Asia featured the regional Innovators Under 35 Asia honourees. Selected by a distinguished panel of judges, 10 young innovators under the age of 35 presented a three-minute elevator pitch on the EmTech stage. Their inventions and research were found to be most ground-breaking and exciting from a regional list of nominations.
