  - o Why you cannot provide parental financial information on the 2019-20 FAFSA

Include documentation to support your appeal for independent status; examples include:

- o court orders of permanent status
- o death certificates
- o verification of incarceration
- o At least two letters from adult professionals who can verify your family circumstances. Adult professionals include clergy members, attorneys, school guidance counselors, medical doctors, mental health professionals, teachers, law enforcement or court officers, and professional staff associated with Child Protective Services.
- If you filed taxes and did not use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to complete the FAFSA income section, then you must submit a copy of your 2017 and/or 2018 Federal Income Tax Return Transcript. This can be requested online at <a href="https://www.irs.gov">www.irs.gov</a>.

<u>Section B – Renewal Request</u>: If you were approved for a Dependency Override in a previous academic year/term, you may be asked to provide supporting documentation or clarification.

- Attach a personal statement with your name, student ID#, date and signature summarizing your current situation and any changes that may have occurred since you were originally granted a dependency override. Your signed and dated letter must include the following:
