


## **Student Tuition Fees**





- ✓ Open an Australian BANK ACCÓUNT
- ✓ Have PERMISSION to work in Australia
- ✓ Student VISA: Maximum of 40 hours per fortnight
- ✓ Working Holiday VISA: Unlimited working hour
- ✓ Tourist/Visitor VISA no work allowed. Visit the website for this government department for more information

### Visa information

All students should be aware of their VISA conditions:

- Have a course of study (eCOE)
- 2. Maintain satisfactory course progress
- 3. Work up to 40 hours per fortnight in study periods
- Update your current personal details and address to the school regularly. This is <u>VERY</u> important.
- 5. Have VISA length Overseas Health Cover (OSHC).

# **Health & Safety**





#### Safety in our building

- Building is open 7.30am 9.00pm, Monday Friday
- Floors 1 5 are open on weekends Security access card required
- Please do not hold the elevators and front doors, as they are ALARMED
- Stairs are located at FRONT and REAR of the building
- Toilets are located in the front stairwells, and disabled toilets are located on levels 1, 3, 4 and 5



#### **Evacuation Information**

#### IF YOU HEAR THE FOLLOWING ALARMS:

#### Alert Alarm - 'Beep, Beep'

Action: All wardens to respond. Staff to check immediate area for signs of danger and stand by. If alarms sound outside of normal business hours, immediately evacuate.

#### Evacuation Alarm - 'Whoop, Whoop'

Action: Evacuate via the nearest exit and proceed to the assembly area.

#### **EVACUATION PROCEDURES:**

- Assist any person in immediate danger ONLY IF SAFE to do so.
- Activate the Fire Break Glass Alarm (Manual Call Point) and call Emergency Services (000).
- Attack fire with the appropriate equipment ONLY IF SAFE to do so.


#### On being advised of a Building Evacuation...

- Comply with all instructions given by Chrief Fire Warden or Wardens.
- Leave the building via the nearest safe emergency EXIT.
- Proceed to the building's Emergency Assembly Area and remain there until otherwise advised.

- √ Visit a doctor or chemist






