## 2019 Teddy Award Winner

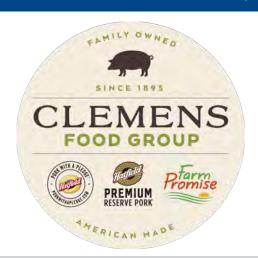
