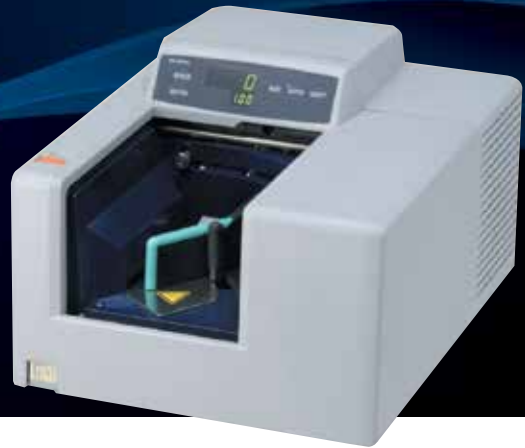

The GND-710 offers high-speed counting based of Glory's reliable vacuum feed system. Selectable counting speeds, including the fastest speed in the industry of 2400 notes per minute, allows the GND-710 to easily handle any grade banknote. Adjustable count positions locate the best note position to minimize challenges other counters may have with pinholes or corner folds.

Ease of Use

Equipped with auto-start functionality, simply set the notes in the holder to start operation. The easy-to-read LED display on the compactly designed operation panel ensures a clear view of both the grand total, up to four digits and the batch total up to 3 digits simultaneously. It also allows for quickly switching between count modes.

Multiple Modes of Operation

With 4 different operating modes, the GND-710 can meet varying demands.

Count Mode: All notes placed in the holder will be counted with a running total and final tally displayed.

Alarm Mode: An alarm sounds and the holder automatically locks, alerting the operator of a strap count discrepancy.

Batch Mode: The preset batch number is easily selected on the display and counting will automatically stop when the present number is reached.

Addition Mode: The grand total accumulates as each new strap or loose bundle is counted.
