



NedCard expanding clean-room capacity

NedCard announced today that its Directors and Supervisory Board have approved the plan to further expand the clean-room space of NedCard ϕ Smart Card Module Assembly and Test facility in China, enabling the company to further grow its globally installed production capacity to 1,5 billion this year up to an estimated 2,6 billion units per year by 2018.

The Shanghai based high-tech and high-secure factory was first started in April 2008, at that point the factory activity was kept limited to the first floor of the three storey factory building. In 2011, already an additional clean room on the second floor was taken into operation. NedCard ϕ continuous strong growth however, especially in the markets for Banking and Identification as well as a growing demand in other areas, has now created the need for additional clean room space.

The clean room expansion on the third floor is expected to be completed by the end of July 2015.
