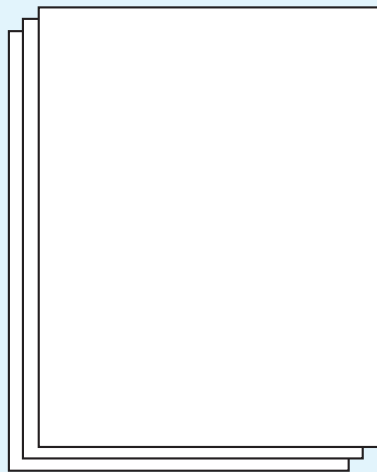
Monster Hunt

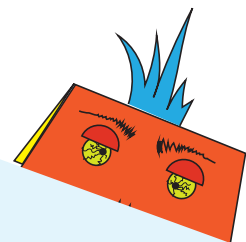

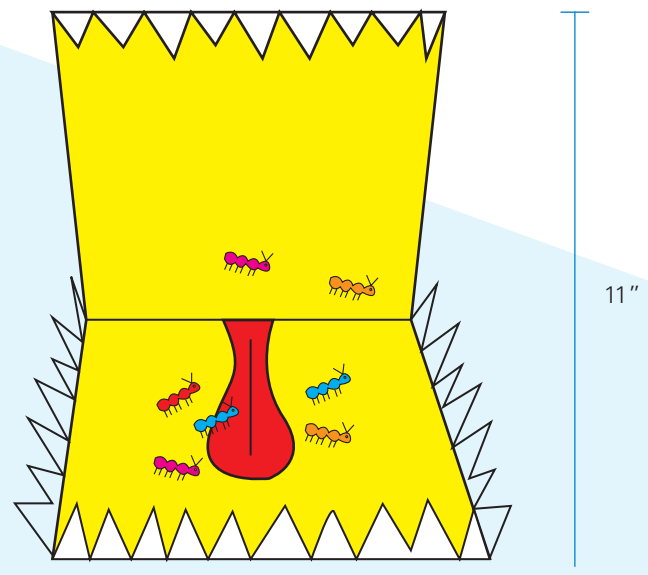
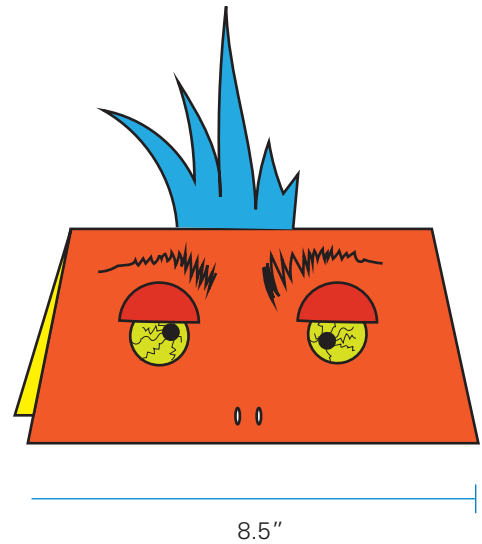

- 7 Have a monster party.

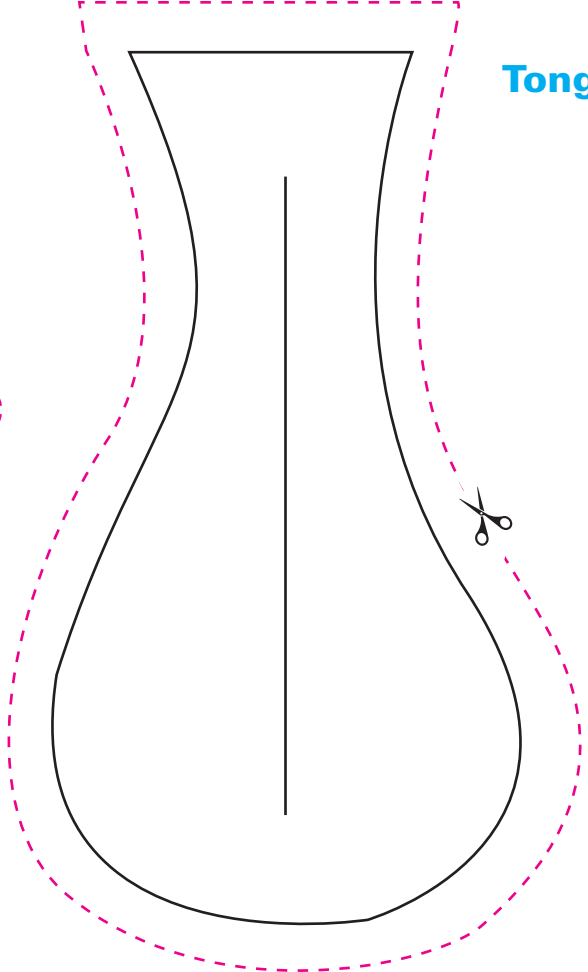
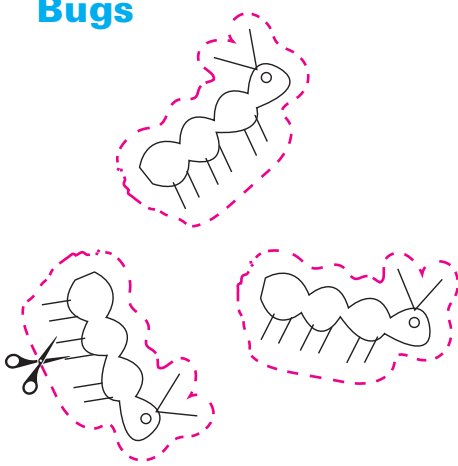
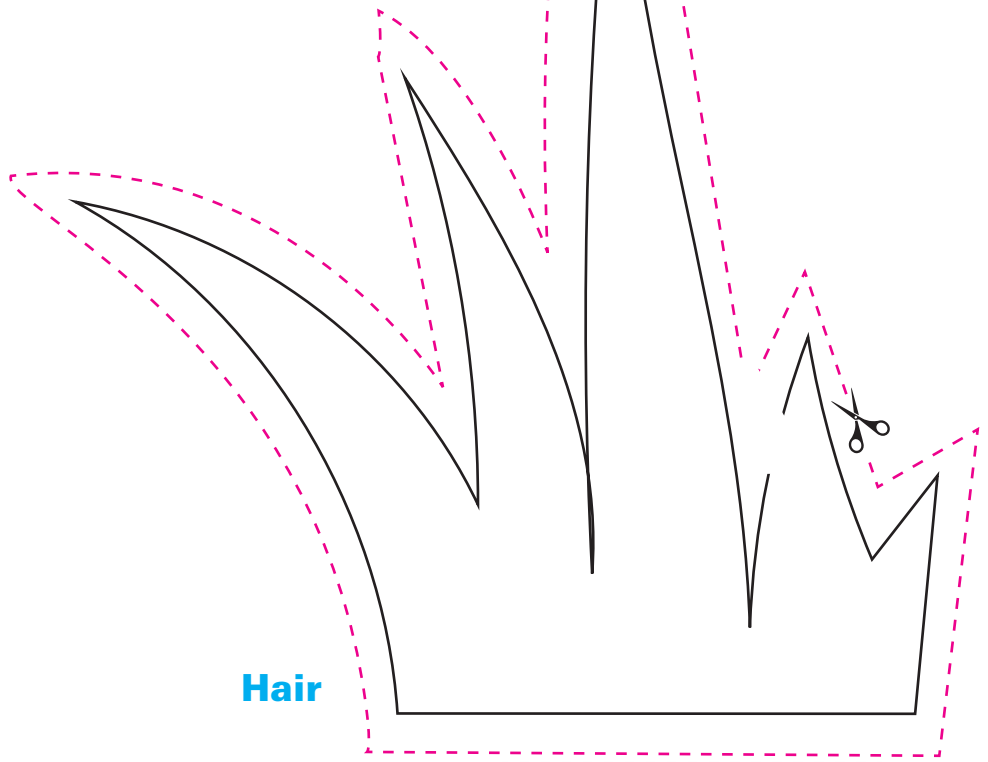
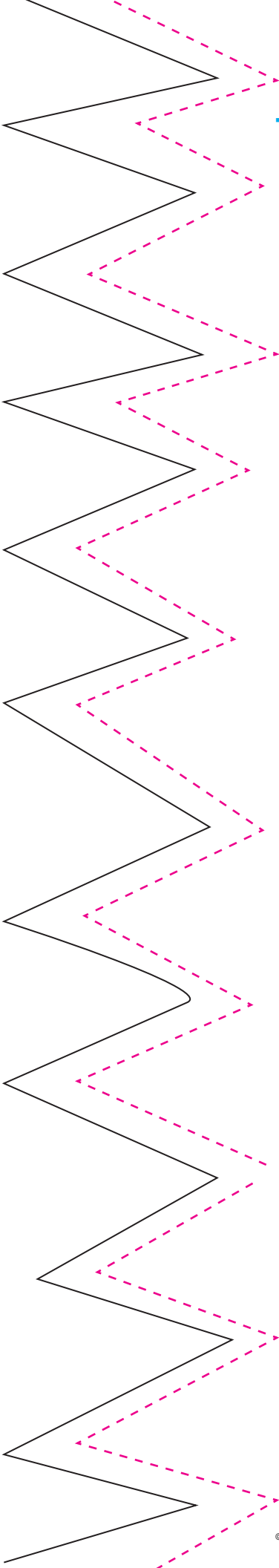
