


What You Will Need

Wizard Hat




Step 1

Cut a half circle from 11" x 17" inch paper to fit your head.




Step 2

Roll up paper to form a cone and tape securely.



Step 3

On second sheet, trace a circular plate. Place cone in the center of traced plate and trace around the cone.



Step 4

Cut out brim, slip over cone, and tape.



Step 5

Decorate! Cut out moons and stars or add your own sparkle star stickers.



Poof!

Crown



Step 1

Take the leftover Goldenrod paper and fold it accordionstyle to make a crown.



Step 2

Cut the top at an angle.



Step 3

Unfold accordion.
