

Your Interview

How to Prepare

- 1 Do research to understand our culture and mission. Be prepared to answer questions about how your personal mission aligns with our calling to extend the healing ministry of Christ through whole-person care.
- 2 Consider the strengths you bring to this position and how your past experiences have helped prepare you for this role. If you do not have experience in the area you are interviewing for, be ready to explain why you are interested in the position/unit and what skills will help you succeed in this new role.
- 3 Be prepared to answer challenge questions and provide situational examples about patient experience, safety and satisfaction.
- 4 Write down a list of questions that you have about the job responsibilities, team dynamics, or hospital you are interviewing at. Interviewing is a two-way form of communication, and it's important that you check us out as well to ensure we are a good fit for you!
- 5 Dress professionally.
- 6 Bring extra copies of your resume.
- 7 Bring a separate list of references.
