

### Introduction

St Peters Cathedral has been standing in the North Adelaide Parklands since 1876 and has since become one of the most famous and recognisable buildings in Adelaide. Recent developments have seen pavers from Best Bricks and Pavers laid around the surrounding edges of the Cathedral. It was important to keep the historical integrity of the Cathedral while updating the pavers, which Best Bricks and Pavers have achieved through using Large Format Pavers in elegant colours.

Slate Bevel, Slate Bevel Honed and Oyster Bevel Honed Large Format Pavers were all used to complete this project. 300 x 300 x60mm pavers were used in all three of these finishes.



### Patterns

The architecture of the Cathedral allowed for an interesting paving pattern. The indented sections of the Cathedral are complimented with Oyster Bevel Pavers, which is broken by sections of Slate Bevel Pavers that align with the pillars. The outer path consists of purely slate bevel pavers.

### Outdoor Space

The paving pattern surrounding St Peter's Cathedral is a perfect example of how you can tie pavers together with the architecture of a building to create an eye catching yet traditional design. When looking at pavers for your next project, do not be afraid to fit pavers in with your architecture.

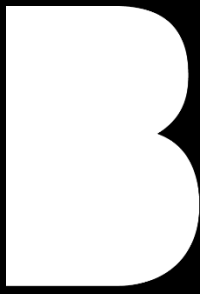
