

### Introduction

Best Bricks & Pavers was commissioned to find a flooring solution to add chic to the new UniSA Health and Innovation Building. Using Terrazzo tiles both indoors and out, the finished project stood true to the mission.

Granite Nuit Terrazzo tiles in both honed and black series and a range of different sizes were used to complete the project. The differing sizes were used in a range of patterns to create a visually stunning look that perfectly complements the unique architecture of the building.



### Internally

Internally, 400x400mm Terrazzo tiles were laid in a stretcher bond pattern with 400x100mm Terrazzo tiles used to create borders, break up sections and add some flair.

Externally, the Terrazzo tiles are also laid in sections of stretcher bond pattern with a strip of lighter tiles between sections that tie in perfectly with concrete benches in the area.

The Terrazzo tiles used in the outdoor aspect of this project feature Best's black series finish. Therefore, they adhere to the highest level of slip resistance according to Australian Standard 4586:13, making them safe to use in outdoor areas subject to rain. Using non-slip resistant Terrazzo tiles in outdoor pedestrian areas can potentially lead to serious injury.
