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THE PROGRAM

The University of Prescott is a two-year educational program which provides a solid foundation for a career in the waterworks industry.

Students accepted into the program become full-time apprentices of the company and are paid a stipend. Upon graduation, students are placed in permanent positions within the company based on skills, abilities, aptitude and company needs.

University of Prescott students learn in a hands-on environment. Along with classroom, product, and industry training, the students work closely with experienced employees at various locations. The training is comprehensive and covers all aspects of company operations. Successful students gain much more than product knowledge. They develop a clear understanding of the principles that form the foundation of any successful career path.

Each student is assigned a mentor. The company's experienced mentors guide the students through the program, striving to build on their strengths and help them develop to their highest potential.

As full-time company apprentices, University of Prescott students receive health benefits, life insurance and all other employee benefits. Transportation and travel expenses are paid by the company.
