

11th GRADE SUPPLY LIST

Below are the supplies students will need to start the school year. Other supplies may be needed; however teachers will work with students to minimize items brought to school. Items that can be left at home will be addressed the first week of school.

BRING TO CCS AT ORIENTATION (Aug. 20):

LAST NAME BEGINNING WITH A-G :	Bring 1 roll select-a-size paper towels, 1 pack of multi colored cardstock, 1 box of tissues, and one ream of white copy paper
LAST NAME BEGINNING WITH H-N :	Bring 1 container of Clorox wipes, 1 pack of colored copier paper, 1 box of tissues, and one ream of white copy paper
LAST NAME BEGINNING WITH O-Z :	Bring 1 container of Clorox wipes, 1 pack of dry erase markers, 1 box of tissues, and one ream of white copy paper

BRING TO PARKWOOD BAPTIST ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL (Aug. 21):

- ☐ Each student needs to have a zipper pouch large enough to keep pencils, blue or black ink pens, red erasable pens, highlighters, and colored pencils to carry with them to all classes.
- ☐ Two-inch 3-ring binder with 6 dividers labeled for each subject (dividers must have pockets)- Chemistry, U.S. History, English 11, Math, Apologetics, Spanish
- ☐ College-ruled paper in each section of the binder
- ☐ Pack of Avery or Post-it tabs (to use to subdivide subjects in binder later)
- ☐ Green, yellow, orange, blue highlighters in your zipper pouch
- ☐ Colored pencils in your zipper pouch
- ☐ Composition notebook with sewn binding (U.S. History)
- ☐ Scientific calculator (Chemistry)
- ☐ Index cards and index card storage(Chemistry)
- ☐ Composition notebook with sewn binding (Chemistry)
- ☐ Commonplace book- please select an unlined, glued or sewn-binding journal. The best size is 7 ½ x 9 7/8 inches but slightly smaller (7 x 5 ½) is okay too. Books should have at least 90-100 pages (please don't get a smaller one or your student will need a second one before the year is through). Feel free to choose something your student loves!
