

7th GRADE SUPPLY LIST

- Each student needs to have a zipper pouch large enough to keep pencils, blue or black ink pens, red erasable pens, highlighters, and colored pencils to carry with them to all classes.
- Each student needs to bring a ream of white copy paper.

LAST NAME BEGINNING WITH **A-G**: Bring 1 roll select-a-size paper towels, 1 pack of multi colored cardstock, and 1 box of tissues

LAST NAME BEGINNING WITH **H-N**: Bring 1 container of Clorox wipes, 1 pack of colored copier paper, and 1 box of tissues

LAST NAME BEGINNING WITH **O-Z**: Bring 1 container of Clorox wipes, 1 pack of dry erase markers, and 1 box of tissues

All upper school students must have the ability to bring a laptop or notebook computer of some kind to school when needed for a particular class. Teachers will instruct students in advance of when they will need to use a device in class. The device need not belong solely to the student (borrowing one from mom, dad, or a sibling is fine). Students also need access to a printer in order to turn in typed assignments such as research papers, essays, etc.

All upper school students must have a Bible to use in class and in chapel (literal translation such as New American Standard Version, English Standard Version, New American Standard, or King/New King James Version; not a children's or paraphrase version/edition)
