## Binders/Folders/Notebooks- Labeled with names

- 1 Plastic YELLOW folder pockets only
- 1 Plastic BLUE folder pockets only
- 1 Plastic 3 pronged (choice of color) folder

## Pencils/Crayons

- 12 #2 pencils sharpened
- 1 pack of 24-count Crayola crayons
- 2 packs of 12 colored pencils
- 2 large pink pearl erasers

## Paper Products

- 1 ream of white copy paper
- 1 PRIMARY Journals early creative story tablet - (it has a marbled cover – lined paper with space on each page for a picture at top)
