

Instructions for Installing the MAC Plugin

1. When installing the MAC Plugin you may encounter an error. "WebVideoPlugin_(version,etc).pkg" can't be opened because it is from an unidentified developer. (Message will be different based on series/version plugin that is installed)



2. Simply open up System Preferences & Select Security & Privacy.

- 4. Once you have completed these steps your installation should start immediately. If not simply try opening the file again from "downloads" or wherever you have saved the file.
 - If you are having trouble viewing the cameras after you have updated to Mac OS High Sierra then go to Safari/Preferences/Websites/Plug-Ins on your left. Look for "Netscape NVMS9000 Plug-in" and "Netscape WebClient_v2 Plug-in". Toggle the option under configure websites to "On". Now force quit Safari then reopen and revisit the website.
