**WILLIAM FREMD AND ROLLING MEADOWS HIGH SCHOOLS
RECOGNIZED FOR GOODWILL FALL HAUL CHALLENGE**

What: Fall Haul, Goodwill's popular donation challenge, had 300 participating high schools in northern Illinois donating nearly 1.2 million items. St. Joseph School in Westchester won the overall challenge and will, at a later date, receive a visit from two Chicago Blackhawk players at their school. However, Goodwill wanted to recognize the great effort that the second and third place winners achieved. So tomorrow, third place winner William Fremd High School (they donated over 33,800 items) is being recognized at an all-school assembly where Goodwill representatives will present them with a \$500 gift card and plaque honoring the contribution. Rolling Meadows High School placed second, donating 64,600 items, and a presentation will be made to Principal Eileen Hart later in the day.
