Wondering when you'll respond?

While some patients, like Joyce, respond early in treatment, most patients see improvements after about 6 treatments. But it's not uncommon for it to take even longer. In a review of about 100 patients who had success with Urgent PC, symptoms improved anywhere between 2-12 weeks. For about 20% of these patients, the symptoms of urgency and/or urge incontinence began to improve after 8 weeks.

There is no way to anticipate who will respond earlier, later or not at all. That's why it is important to receive the 12 recommended treatments before you and your physician evaluate whether this therapy is an appropriate and effective choice for you.











Lifestyle Goals

Keep drinking!

- <mark>» Drink 6-8 glasses daily</mark>
- » Drink most before dinner
- » Not too much at once

Foods to watch

- » Beverages and foods containing caffeine (chocolate, coffee drinks, sodas)
- » Carbonated beverages (carbonated sodas, carbonated water)
- » Spicy foods
- » Citrus fruits (grapefruit, oranges, lemon, lime)
- » Tomato products
- » Diet products containing aspartame (sugar-free foods/candy, diet soda)
- » Alcohol

Prevent constipation

- » Stay hydrated
- » Eat fiber

Exercise

- » 30-60 minutes/day
- » 4-6 days/week

Keep your weight at a normal level

Losing a few pounds might help you get your bladder symptoms under control. In a 6-month study, an 8% weight loss in obese women (20 lb loss for a 250 lb woman) cut the number of incontinence episodes nearly in half!
