Summary

Purpose

The purpose was to better understand the challenges faced by hospital and health system staff as they manage drug shortages. We received a 16% response rate.

This survey was distributed by LogicStream Health, developers of The Drug Shortage App, to pharmacy staff at hospitals throughout the United States.

The majority of respondents have one of the following job titles: Director of Pharmacy, Pharmacy Manager, Clinical Coordinator, Pharmacy Buyer or Chief Pharmacy Officer.

Demographic

Out of all respondents, 84 percent belonged to organizations with between 200 and 1,000 staffed beds. Twelve percent were less than 200 staffed beds and four percent were over 1,000 staffed beds.

87 percent of respondents are not currently evaluating any sort of application to help with drug shortages.

56 percent of respondents agreed that an application to help manage shortages would be useful in some way to their team. Question 1: On a scale of 1 to 10, with 10 being excruciating, how painful are drug shortages for your team?


Out of all respondents, 96% said their pain was a **six** or above.

Other top challenges included:


- Being more proactive about shortages

How many hours per week does your team spend managing drug shortages?


Out of all respondents, **84%** said they spend more than five hours per week managing shortages. **56%** said they spend more than nine hours a week. **12%** were not sure.
