





Hop on and off the light-rail and take advantage of all three of METRORail's lines to get where you want to go: downtown Houston, NRG Park, the Museum District, the Texas Medical Center, Hermann Park/Houston Zoo, BBVA Compass Stadium, the Theater District and more. Or, rent a bike with Houston's BCycle program, currently operating 38 stations with 275 bikes around the central city, including a station right outside the doors of The Isabella at Midtown.

Life is for living, not for sitting in traffic. Commuting to most of the major business centers of polycentric Houston is a breeze from Midtown.



The Midtown Redevelopment Authority (MRA), launched in 1994, fosters neighborhood economic development and promotes local long-term investment, each contributing to the impressive and consistent growth in Midtown.

The Authority facilitates widening sidewalks in the area, the addition of lighting to pedestrian pathways, the installation of street furniture like park benches and waste receptacles, the integration of shops and residences, all in order to create a homey, clean and exciting walking environment in the heart of Houston.

The Authority recently completed the major Holman Streetscape project to enhance pedestrian areas and encourage mixed-use development. The transformation of Main Street to a pedestrian-friendly avenue is already underway.

Midtown Park (aka "Superblock"), scheduled for completion in phases throughout 2017, will be the pride of Midtown. If you are looking for the perfect picnic spot, a sunny oasis or shaded area to relax, green space, even a wetland stream and trail, the new Midtown Park has something for you and yours.
