Demo! How to use Approval Queues


- Report Writer Jill has several definitions in Drafting and she wants to submit them to Data Stewards
 - Filter to 118 defs move from draft to submit; 73 in Enrollment
 - Background Job page flags Batch Actions
- Data Steward Reggie Stration wants to bulk approve 4 quality rules
 - Uses Filters
 - Approves

Watch out!


- Permissions hold true but it does not prompt early if you select wrong transition action
 - UI indicates you can select transition actions that you really cannot; all transition actions are viewed, not just yours
- Be familiar with your workflow catalog, including workflow versions
- Workflow naming conventions can help

Definition Approval Queue



Review the Steps

- 1. Manipulate top row filters
- 2. Select items
- 3. Take action
- 4. Confirm results

Why use?

- Report writers create new definitions during Specification documentation and can't easily Submit from Spec Template view
- 2. Made bulk edit in multiple definitions and want to bulk progress to next Stage
- 3. Save time in F2F governance/approval meetings. Take bulk actions after the meeting ends
- 4. Override due to unexpected absence
- 5. Convenient! Supports personal work style

Use Case part 2 Manage Content – Manager or Steward

- Monitor progress speed
- Re-assign objects
