

PRIVACY AND COOKIES POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION: Biogelx Ltd. – which has its registered office at BioCity Scotland, Bo'Ness Road, Newhouse, Lanarkshire ML1 5UH, Scotland, UK - as a data controller and processor is committed to preserving your privacy. Please read the following privacy policy to understand how we use and protect the information that you provide to us. By using this website, you consent to the collection, storage, use and transfer of your information under the terms of this policy. We avoid processing special categories of data, these are sensitive personal data that reveal racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, and the processing of genetic data, biometric data for the purpose of uniquely identifying a natural person, data concerning health or data concerning a natural person's sex life or sexual orientation.

2.
