TEACHING METHODS & PLANNING

- 1. Demonstrates a thorough knowledge of subject(s) taught
- 2. Conveys own interest in the lesson, and stimulates students' interest also
- 3. Uses language common to both the teacher and the students
- 4. Builds on what the students already know to teach them what they have yet to learn
- 5. Requires students to be actively engaged in the learning process, and arouses that desire within them
- 6. Enables and requires students to reproduce the learning in a variety of ways (e.g., using other words, explaining, applying)
- 7. Employs effective and varied review of what has been learned so as to make it permanent.
- 8. Creates weekly and 9-week plans consistent with the Curriculum Guide's guidelines and objectives
- 9. Meets course objectives, or calls attention to where this is not on track to happen

ASSIGNMENTS & ASSESSMENT

- Plans and communicates test dates and paper/project dates to students and parents well ahead of time
- 2. Utilizes homework to achieve course objectives, while remaining within homework guidelines
- 3. Designs tests and assignments that are clear, varied, and clearly contribute to course objectives
- 4. Provides feedback on tests and assignments that is prompt, helpful, and makes clear distinctions concerning the quality of work
- 5. Inputs grades into RenWeb promptly according to policy standards
- 6. Submits accurate grades and helpful comments on progress reports and report cards, and completes them in a timely fashion

CLASSROOM DECORUM & DISCIPLINE

- 1. Maintains a neat, clean classroom enhanced by appropriate décor
- 2. Establishes a well-ordered learning environment where expectations are clearly understood
- 3. Enforces discipline policies and guidelines consistently
- 4. Establishes & maintains individual and group rapport with students in and out of classroom

PROFESSIONALISM

- 1. Readily participates in school activities, meetings, and programs
- 2. Demonstrates a desire and commitment to grow in knowledge of subjects taught, their integration into the overall curriculum, and in knowledge of classical, Christian education
- 3. Demonstrates collegiality by helping, encouraging, and working with fellow teachers
- 4. Punctual for required events
- 5. Prompt with paperwork, email, and responds to responsibilities in a timely manner
- 6. Dresses in a professional manner

SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP

- 1. Consistently manifests before students, parents, and colleagues the Fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23)
- 2. Demonstrates a love for God's Word and a commitment to grow in knowledge of it
