#### Private tour of Château Latour

On Wednesday, April 19, *Le Soléal* will sail along the Gironde River at daybreak and drop anchor in Pauillac, the undisputed capital of the Médoc wine-growing region. Médoc has boasted 18 Cru Classés since 1855, including three Premiers. In the early afternoon, you will access Château Latour directly from the Gironde via Zodiac landing craft, using a temporary pontoon installed expressly for the occasion. You will then have the privilege of visiting the estate and touring the vineyards. Once your private visit has come to an end, you will be invited to take part in a tasting of three of Château Latour's exemplary wines.

Our special guests from Château Latour, **Frédéric Engerer** and **Hélène Génin**, will be at your side to show you around the estate, share their passion for great wine, and reveal the secrets of this legendary vintage. Onboard experts **Jean-Robert Pitte** and **Eric Beaumard** will offer advice and insider knowledge as we sample the world-class wines.

Return to *Le Soléal* in the late afternoon to enjoy an aperitif on the deck as the sun sets, with the endless rows of vines serving as a stunning backdrop.

To continue this unforgettable day, join fellow guests at a unique Gala Dinner, hosted by **Chef Alain Ducasse**, whose team will prepare dishes that complement the wines of Château Latour. Chef Ducasse will join passengers in the restaurant as an honored guest.

### Your ala carte wine excursions



#### Porto and Port wine

Sunday, April 16

From Leixoes, take a panoramic tour en route to Porto, a picturesque town in Portugal's Douro region and a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Visit **Taylor's Port Cellars**, one of the most prestigious port merchants. You will have the chance to take a tour with a specialist guide to discover the secrets behind the production of port.

This visit will be followed by a tasting session of a number of the estate's wines, including Tawny and Ruby port, as well as wines up to 10 years old. From the terrace, enjoy a magnificent view of the Douro, the Dom-Luis Bridge, and the old town on the opposite bank.

You will be then driven to the heart of Porto to visit the Church of São Francisco, an architectural marvel which is reputed to be one of the most beautiful examples of Portuguese Baroque architecture. Enjoy breathtaking views over the river before returning to *Le Soléal*.

#### Bordeaux and La Cité du Vin

Thursday, April 20

Recently awarded UNESCO World Heritage status, Bordeaux is a beacon of French winemaking culture. Our stopover in Bordeaux will give you the chance to visit this city, whose architectural beauty rivals that of the surrounding vineyards. Walk past the German submarine base from World War II and the quays of Chartrons where the wine trade began, pause in front of the 18<sup>th</sup>-century Palais Rohan, now the Bordeaux City Hall, then continue your stroll to the Saint André Cathedral. From there, you can admire the Grand Theater—Bordeaux's opera house and one of the most beautiful theaters in Europe—and then wander through the "Vieux Bordeaux" district. Continue your discovery at the newly-opened **Cité du Vin**, which invites visitors to see wine differently—around the world, through the ages, in all cultures and all civilizations. After a self-guided visit of the permanent exhibition, you will be offered a carefully-chosen glass of wine before you return to *Le Soléal*.

#### Discover a wine estate in Saint-Emilion

From Bordeaux, Thursday, April 20

There is no better place to discover the Bordeaux region than the village of Saint-Emilion, a UNESCO World Heritage site and cradle of the Merlot grape. The vineyards on the "hill of a thousand castles" lead us directly to the village, an 18<sup>th</sup>-century walled construction perched on a rocky peak. Discover the village's main monuments: the collegial church and its magnificent 17<sup>th</sup>-century cloister, the ramparts, and the market square. As you stroll through the narrow streets you will also discover the Cadène and the King's Tower.

The visit will continue in one of the neighboring wine estates, such as Franc-Mayne, Faugères, Pressac, Ferrand, or Soutard. The wine-making process will be explained, and you will visit the cellars and attend a wine tasting in the company of the estate's sommeliers.



#### Château Siaurac and its vineyards

From Bordeaux, Thursday, April 20

Siaurac boasts three winemaking regions on the exceptional terroirs of the right bank of the Gironde River.

During this morning excursion, visit the Siaurac estate and château. You will also be invited to enjoy an extensive wine tasting, starting with wines from the three great terroirs of the right bank: Saint-Emilion Grand Cru Classé (Château Le Prieuré), Pomerol (Château Vray Croix de Gay), and Lalande de Pomerol (Château Siaurac). Continue with a wine-tasting workshop that will allow you to discover the three grape varieties that make up Château Siaurac's wines before assemblage and blind-taste a young wine and a more mature wine in order to appreciate the development of the flavor. Lastly, to complete this workshop, sample wines that illustrate the contrasts created by the various terroirs.

The morning will conclude with a fine dinner at the estate, the dishes chosen in harmony with the wines.









