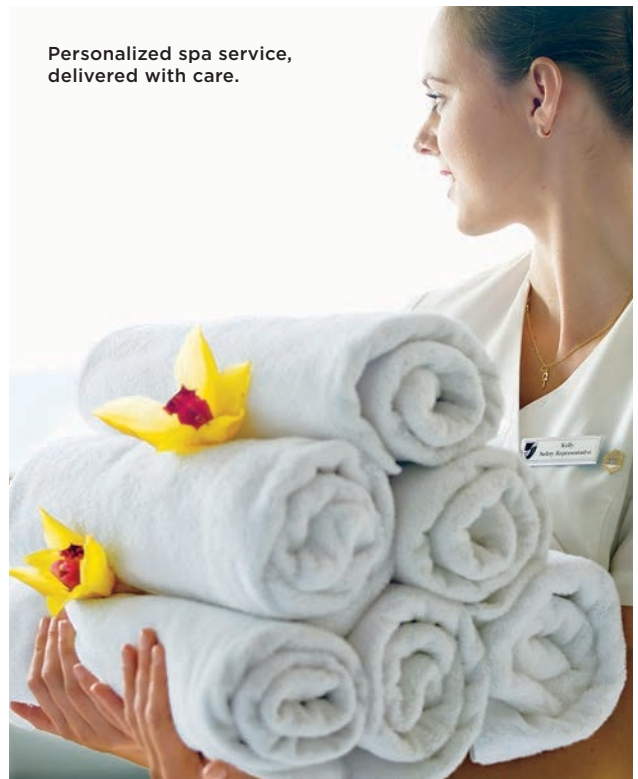

# FRENCH REVIVAL

Have chefs had their fill of cross-cultural mash-ups and single-protein specialty menus? Noteworthy names across the U.S. are getting back to culinary basics with French cuisine.

- Cannes-based restaurateurs David and Fanny Rolland recently opened **Le Petit Paris**, a bustling, breakfast-through-dinner brasserie in downtown L.A.'s historic El Dorado building. The menu lists Eggs Benedict with lobster, croque monsieur, steak tartare, and four different lobster preparations among their numerous seafood options. Two bars encourage late-night lingering.

Stroll the lively Mexican marketplace on Olvera Street before cruising back down legendary Sunset Strip to the **Sunset Tower Hotel**, where you can apply a \$100 credit toward California-fresh cuisine at the acclaimed modern brasserie, Tower Bar.

- The French revival is a homecoming of sorts for many chefs. "I wanted to go back to the roots of my training with elegant but approachable food," says Jason Paskewitz, chef/owner of the new **Blanchard** in Chicago. Standouts at the Lincoln Park bistro include the four-item foie gras menu and a modernized duck à l'orange.

Sushi and plenty of fresh seafood are on the menu at Michelin-starred NoMI Kitchen, located in the **Park Hyatt Chicago**. A \$100 hotel credit lets you sample the acclaimed restaurant, which has recently undergone a casually elegant transformation.

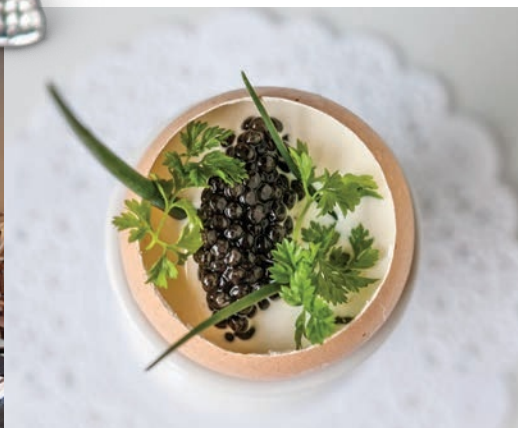
- In Nashville, the talents behind The Catbird Seat and other local hits have just opened **Le Sel** with chef Rene De Leon. The menu includes family-style dishes, such as salt-crusted grouper and braised veal shank, meant to feed four or more. One- to six-person seafood platters abet the convivial spirit.

The restaurant is just minutes away from the fashionable **Hutton Hotel**, where you're treated to a complimentary lunch for two at the 1808 Grille, touted for its New American cuisine.

- French cuisine has made a comeback in "La Grande Pomme," as well, with bistros and boulangeries popping up across New York City. In Brooklyn's Bushwick neighborhood, **Mominette** has made headlines with its coq au vin, absinthe tastings and live jazz; dine alfresco on the inviting patio with an herb garden and petanque court.

Stay at **The Greenwich Hotel** in trendy Tribeca, where you can enjoy a Bamboo Glow body treatment with your \$100 spa services credit.

# A TASTE FOR TEL AVIV

Tel Aviv is home to the colorful Levinsky Market – one of the best places in Israel to get spices, dried fruit and regional specialties – as well as the hip Neve Tzedek neighborhood with its café culture and bustling nightlife. 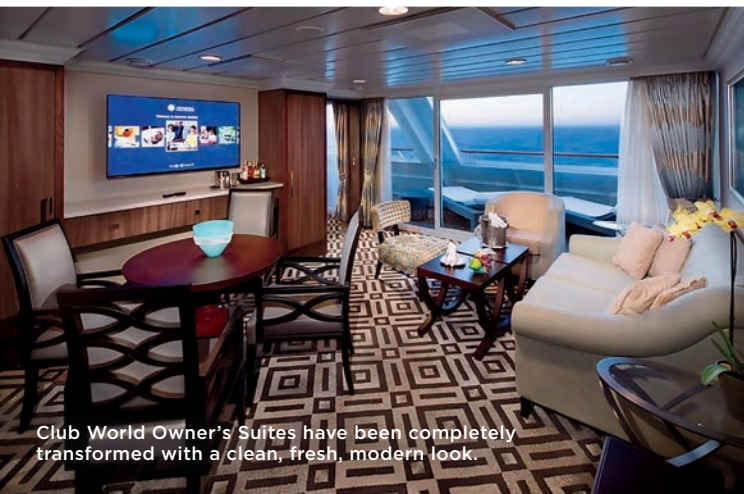

# Spice of Life

While most people think of spices as being merely a way to flavor their food, aromatic seeds, leaves, berries, and herbs were once highly prized commodities worth more than gold. Many wars have been fought over them, and world empires have been built – and lost – in their pursuit. Here are some tidbits about a few popular seasonings, along with ways to spice up your travels.

## Kaffir Lime

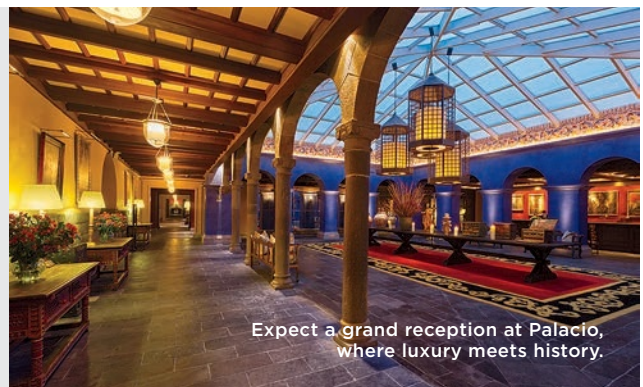

## VAUD, SWITZERLAND

Each region of Switzerland boasts a distinctive language, culture, and cuisine – and a carefully preserved wine-making heritage. The canton of Vaud in “French Switzerland,” for example, claims a number of important wine regions that grow the dominant Chasselas varietal; sloping vineyards along Lake Geneva take advantage of the reflecting light to ripen Chardonnay and Pinot Gris grapes.

**DO IT:** Pedal to a charming wine-making village outside of Savigny for lunch with wine overlooking the lush vineyards. ## CANARY ISLANDS

President Jefferson favored wines from the volcanic Canary Islands archipelago, a Spanish territory just off the southern coast of Morocco. The seven islands, each of which has a unique microclimate and nutrient-rich volcanic soil, produce some 30 indigenous varieties. What's more, Canary grapevines were spared the ravages of phylloxera, which nearly wiped out wine-making in nineteenth-century Europe.

**DO IT:** Visit one of the leading wineries in the UNESCO-designated town of San Cristobal de la Laguna when the 1,996-passenger *Norwegian Spirit* calls on Tenerife during an 11-day voyage round-trip from Barcelona. On Las Palmas, you also can join **NORWEGIAN CRUISE LINE**'s optional tour to Valle de Agaete to taste local award-winning wines.



## GUADALUPE VALLEY, MEXICO

Just an hour's drive from the San Diego border, Valle de Guadalupe feels a lot like Napa Valley, but with a more relaxed, Old World charm. All along Baja California's *Ruta del Vino* from Tijuana to Cabo San Lucas, you'll find rolling vineyards and boutique wineries producing exceptional Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon; you'll find fine Chardonnays, Sauvignon Blancs, and other whites as well. Between tastings, soak in healing hot springs and wander through charming towns.

**DO IT:** **ABSOLUTE TRAVEL** takes guests to Lebanon's oldest winery - Ksara, established in 1857 - for tastings of its fine wines and world-renowned arak.
