Senior Allegiance's New Resident Care Program (Free)

Treemont Retirement has a "Preferred Provider" agreement with Senior Allegiance, Inc. to offer Home Health and Personal Assistance services for Treemont residents. Senior Allegiance maintains staff based at Treemont to provide cost effective care for our residents.

As part of the Agreement, Senior Allegiance provides a range of services for FREE to new residents, during the first 3 days after a new move-in to Treemont. We find these services to be very valuable in helping new residents more quickly feel comfortable in their new home and deal with the normal stress associated with any move.

Senior Allegiance will provide escorts to the dining room for the first 72 hours, and also provides "wellness checks" twice a day. Senior Allegiance will coordinate with family members to determine the best approach for these services. In some cases, family members may be available to help for the first two days, and would ask Senior Allegiance to follow-up for days 3, 4 and 5. In other cases the family members may want to be able to interact with the Senior Allegiance staff starting immediately upon move-in. Senior Allegiance is flexible in how these initial services are scheduled in order to best meet the needs of our new residents and their families.

<u>"On-Call" Agreement with Senior Allegiance.</u> Treemont suggests that you register with Senior Allegiance for "as requested" services at the time of your initial move-in. This registration will put an agreement in place which will allow you to request services in the future, if you want to add temporary care for an illness or other "one time" need. There is no up-front cost, and it avoids delays that can be associated with required paperwork under state license requirements.
