



Health & Safety Program Audits

For clients who manage high-risk onsite suppliers and want to confirm these suppliers maintain adequate safety manuals, **BROWZ** performs health and safety manual audits.

BROWZ collects, audits, and verifies supplier Health & Safety manuals for compliance with regulatory standards at the program and program element level according to a suppliers work-type (Industry Code) or risk level.

BROWZ will identify program and/or program element deficiencies, and relay that information to suppliers, with detailed information on what must be remedied to provide them the opportunity to make corrections. Deficiencies are reported with automated notifications to suppliers along with personal communication from the BROWZ support team.

Key Features Include:

- Segment your supplier database and only audit the safety manuals of the suppliers you elect based on risk level or other criteria.
- Integrate audits with other BROWZ supplier data.
- Tracking health and safety manual compliance over time.
- Audit programs against industry standards such as OSHA 1910.
- Personal support and guidance provided for your suppliers.

Key Benefits Include:

- Ensuring suppliers programs and program elements are regulatory compliant.
- Driving improvement and accountability within the supply chain.
- Implementing program audits where internal administrative costs previously made them unaffordable.
- Auditing "relevant" safety program elements. Unlike competitors, BROWZ only requires those elements pertinent to the suppliers job function, resulting in less onerous prequalification.
