**SUBJECT : FREEZEMASTER™ ANTIFREEZE CANADIAN COMPLIANCE**

Dear Customer,

The purpose of this message is to provide you with information regarding the Canadian compliance status of Freezemaster™ Antifreeze. This letter is in junction to the compliance language located in Section 15 of the Canadian and US SDS.

Freezemaster™ Antifreeze is comprised of components listed on Canada's Chemical Inventory, known as the Domestic Substance List (DSL). However, one polymer in the Freezemaster™ Antifreeze formulation is not listed on Canadian DSL. According to Canada's Guidelines for the Notification and Testing of New Substances: Chemicals and Polymers:

1. A polymer that is not listed on the Canadian DSL may be imported at quantities <1 MT/year
2. A polymer that is not listed on the Canadian DSL must be registered should import quantities exceed >1 MT/year



Given the regulation and the prevalence of the unlisted polymer in our product, you may import the following quantities of Freezemaster™ Antifreeze into Canada:

- < 10,370,000gallons/year or < 44,444 MT/year
