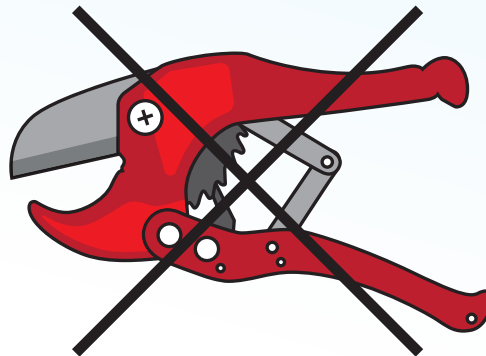
How to Make the Cut When Working With Aged CPVC
