geoAMPS executive presents to IRWA Illinois chapter

During the recent Spring Business Meeting of the Illinois Chapter of the International Right of Way Association (IRWA) Chapter 12, Yogesh Khandelwal, President and Chief Executive Officer of geoAMPS presented how technology from geoAMPS is rapidly changing the right of way industry.
