

SingleSource Decentralised Identity and Risk Scoring Protocol

Project overview

SingleSource is a decentralised identity protocol and risk scoring protocol (SingleSource protocol) that draws on the key principles of a self-sovereign identity, solves the problem of trust and enables global interoperability between various platforms.

The SingleSource protocol puts control over the ownership and accessibility of personal information and Risk Scores in the hands of the individual, enabling them to interact directly with service organisations using their SingleSource Digital Identity and Risk Scores as a basis for obtaining services (e.g. onboarding, financing, insurance claim, etc). The SingleSource protocol provides service organisations transparency over attested statements of fact (e.g. identity verification, transaction history, bank account balance, account defaults) about the individual and absolute confidence that the Risk Score cannot be artificially manipulated.

Main sale

SingleSource is conducting a USD 25m token sale to build and promote its decentralised identity and risk scoring protocol (SingleSource protocol). A total of 650,000,000 CERTI tokens will be issued during the token sale.

CERTI tokens are considered utility tokens and can be redeemed for services rendered within the CERTI ecosystem or traded on an exchange. The CERTI token ecosystem operates on an earn and spend model, depending on the type of activities undertaken.

Key facts

1. SingleSource successfully raised USD 5m in a pre-sale in February 2018, and has established SingleSource Platform Pte. Ltd as the platform and token issuer in Singapore.
2. SingleSource has a team of 14 staff in New Zealand and is well into the development of the decentralised identity and risk scoring protocol.
3. SingleSource's KYC and Crypto-AML products went live in January 2018 and have screened USD 350m of investments across six major ICO's and helped simplify the KYC onboarding process.
4. We showed a live demo of our alpha decentralised identity and risk scoring protocol on blockchain at the Japan Blockchain Conference in June to over 13,000 attendees.
5. SingleSource is the world's first blockchain company to be endorsed by a government agency (New Zealand Department of Affairs) to be able to verify identity documents.
6. Founding member of the New Zealand Digital Identity Forum, a non-profit body aimed at helping transform New Zealand through digital identity.
7. Received a Callaghan Innovation grant (a New Zealand government grant) in August 2018.
8. A top 80 finalist (out of 700+ international companies) in the Singapore Government sponsored Hackcelerator Programme.
