

Tree Watering Guidelines

1ST Year - Water your trees every three to seven days or so, unless there has been a rainfall of 1" or more during that period. This is most important when you move in your home for the first two months and especially during the summer months. Ten to fifteen gallons of water are required for each watering.

2ND Year – Water your trees every fourteen days during the summer months and as needed during the Spring and Fall, unless there has been 1" or more of rainfall during that period. Fifteen to twenty gallons of water are required for each watering.

Residential sprinkler systems do not provide adequate water for a tree. Trees like to be watered and then have time to dry out.
