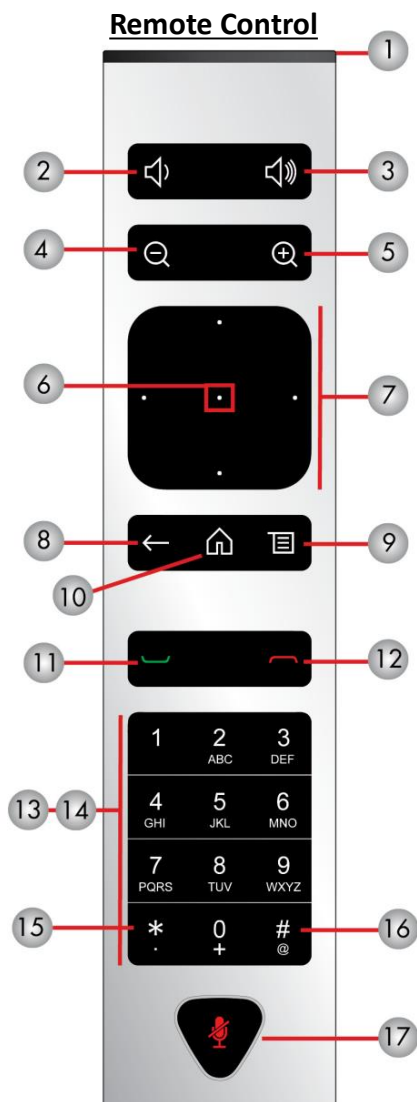

Remote Control Description

- 1 LED IR emitter
- 2 Decrease speaker volume
- 3 Increase speaker volume
- 4 Zoom camera out
- 5 Zoom camera in
- 6 Select
- 7 Menu navigation and Camera Control (Up, Down, Left, and Right)
- 8 Backspace and Previous Page
- 9 Soft Menu
- 10 Home Screen (Main Menu)
- 11 Place or answer a call (Also Power On)
- 12 End or reject a call (Also Power Off)
- 13 Keypad – numbers or letters
- 14 Preset camera selection in camera mode
- 15 * or dot
- 16 # or @ symbol
- 17 Mutes microphone
- 18 Rechargeable Battery (Not Shown)

- Devices auto answer 24 x 7

Placing Calls and Call Control

1. Speed Dial - Select entry on the **Home** Screen
2. State Directory – Press **Place a Call** - Select **Contacts** and then either select the desired entry through the **alphabetic list** OR use the **Search** field to do a partial name search for the desired contacts entry.
3. Manual Call - Press **Place a Call** and enter the destination dialing string in the field and press the **Place a Call** button
 - o Dialing String Formats:
 - Extension@IP (e.g. 135@12.232.9.10)
 - IP##Extension (e.g. 12.232.9.10##135)
 - IP Only (e.g. 75.41.109.236)
4. Answer a Call - Press **Answer** on the remote control.
5. End a Call - Press **End** on the remote control.
6. Mute Your Microphone - Press **Mute** on the remote control or on the Mic Array
7. Adjust the Volume - Press **Speaker Volume** on the remote control.
8. Change Camera View – Quickly press and release Preset number during a call to change views
9. Display Content – Connect content HDMI cable to PC or alternate device. Audio and video play .
