

COVID-19 Convalescent Plasma Donor

South Bend Medical Foundation, in partnership with Logansport Memorial Hospital, is looking for people who have fully recovered from COVID-19 to donate plasma for an investigational treatment option to help current patients with serious, life-threatening COVID-19 infections. This is an exciting opportunity for LMH to work with SBMF and collect plasma here locally, in the north central Indiana region. How it works...

As a result of your infection, your plasma now contains COVID-19 antibodies, which is one way your immune system fought the virus when you were sick. Your plasma is now known as **convalescent plasma** and can be transfused to other patients to be used as a safe and effective therapy that reduces the length and severity of COVID-19.

Want to donate plasma? Here's what you need to know...

Testing Dates at Logansport Memorial Hospital: **May 27, June 3, June 10, June 17**

Call **(574) 204-4243** or visit www.sbfm.org to submit your information. A SBMF representative will review your eligibility and discuss the process with you. Verify that you will be donating your plasma at Logansport Memorial Hospital.

Bring your COVID-19 testing results with you!

There will be no charge for your donation. You will not be paid for you convalescent plasma donation.

You must be **SYMPTOM FREE** for **14 days** before your plasma donation.

There will only be 8—10 donations per day at Logansport Memorial Hospital, so you must submit your information and schedule an appointment time before coming in to donate plasma.

If you have ever been pregnant, you must be tested for HLA antibodies and found to be negative prior to donating.
