- Ensuring SOPs covering clinical and data management activities meet GCP requirements
- Performing GCP training for clinical staff and external collaborators
- Acting as the liaison with academic and commercial partners for GCP compliance issues
- Performing general QMS activities

- Relevant experience in auditing and/or monitoring clinical studies, ideally covering studies in both commercial and non-commercial environments
- Comprehensive knowledge of GCP regulations and demonstrated ability to apply this knowledge
- Understanding of clinical computer systems compliance requirements as they relate to data management and data integrity in GCP and computer systems

- Ability to operate proactively and with minimal supervision, as well as part of a team

- Experience of GCP aspects of imaging studies desirable, but not essential
