Salesforce documentation is both a single source of truth about how your Org is set up, and an evolving record of how it changes over time.

Great documentation should show you, at-a-glance, all customizations and their downstream dependencies to scripts, reports, forms and other types of APEX metadata.

Manual vs. Automatic Documentation

Source	Spreadsheet/Google Doc
Location	Outside Salesforce
Effort Required	Time-consuming to maintain
Accuracy	Prone to human error
Reliabilty	Unverifiable

Why Is Documentation Important?

Productivity — avoid hours of discovery when investigating a potential change

 $\ensuremath{\mbox{Risk}}$ mitigation — know what's safe to change and what requires further investigation
